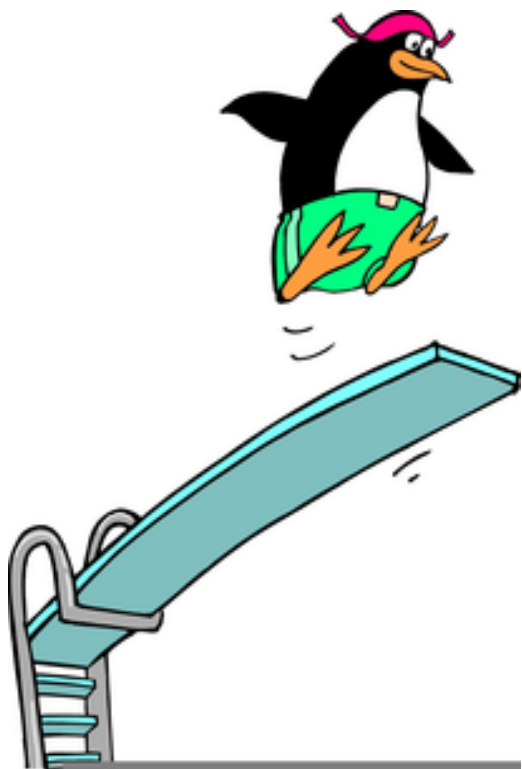

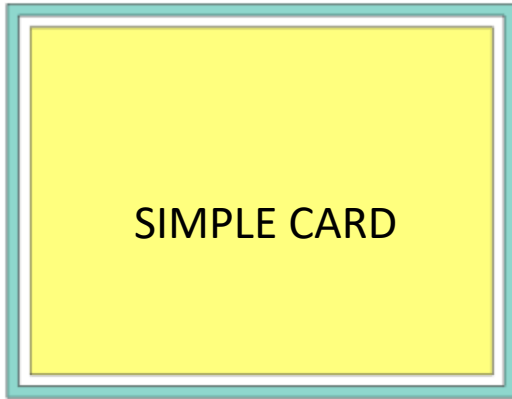
Why #loveitchopit ??

- How many of you have STACKS and boxes and shelves of BEAUTIFUL Designer Series Paper ?

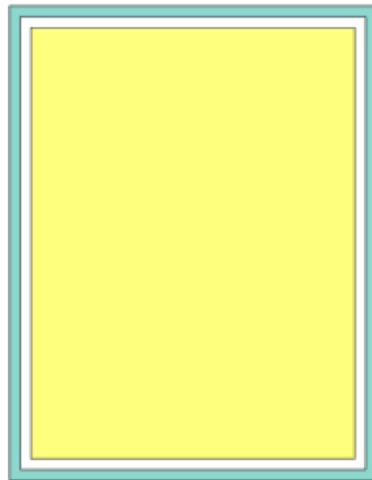


Using Stamp Cases to store your chopped Designer Series Paper makes this sooo much easier!

How I put my cards together

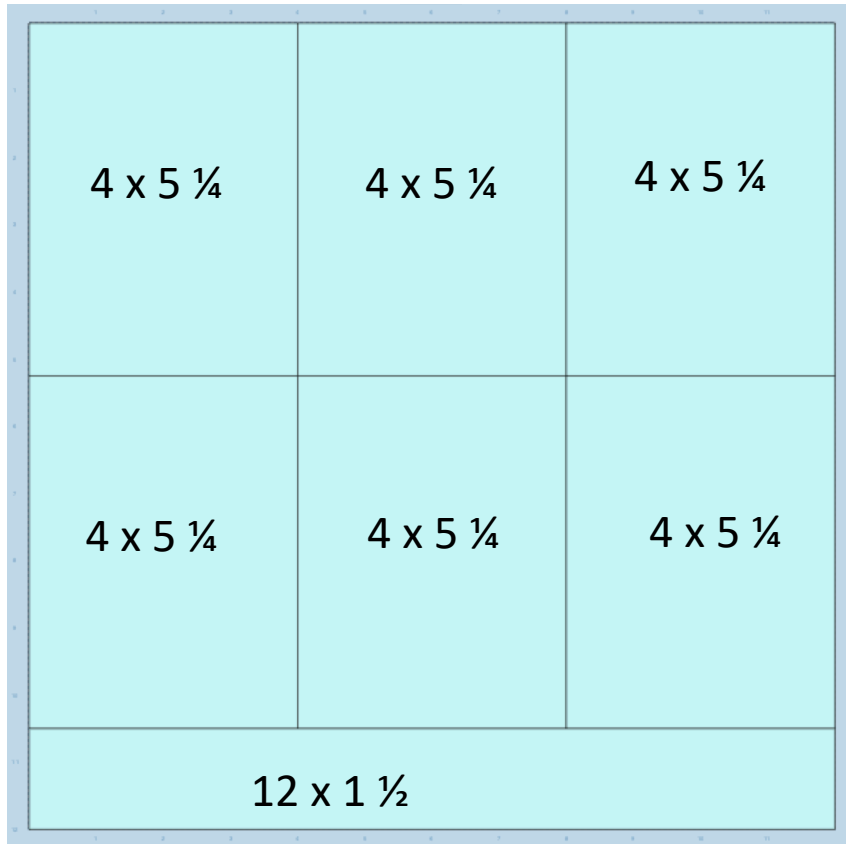


- $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ scored at $4 \frac{1}{4}$
- next layer $4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$
- and $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 5$ layer
- Add embellishment and stamp, ribbon and bling



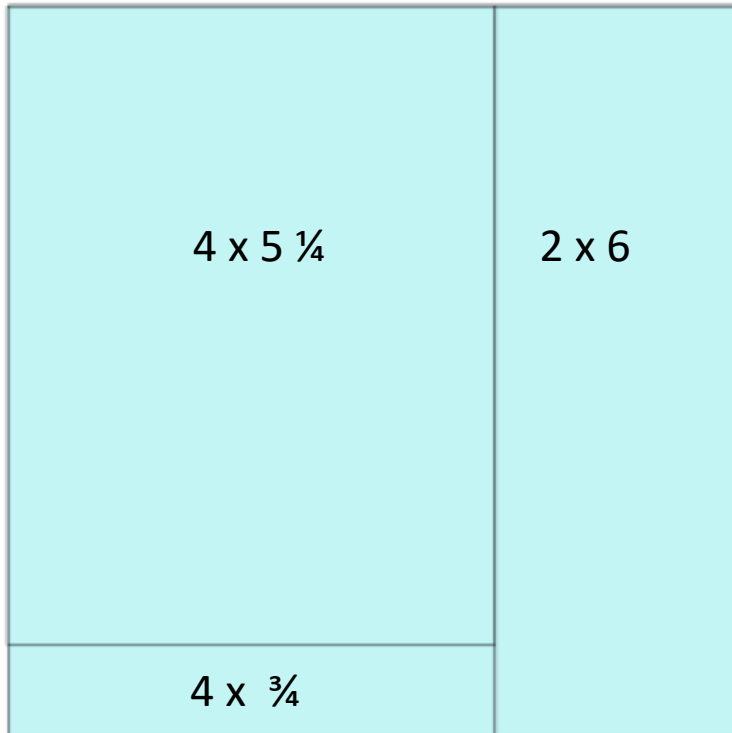
So that means I want both $4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ and $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 5$ layers in my DSP

12 x12 Designer Series Paper DSP

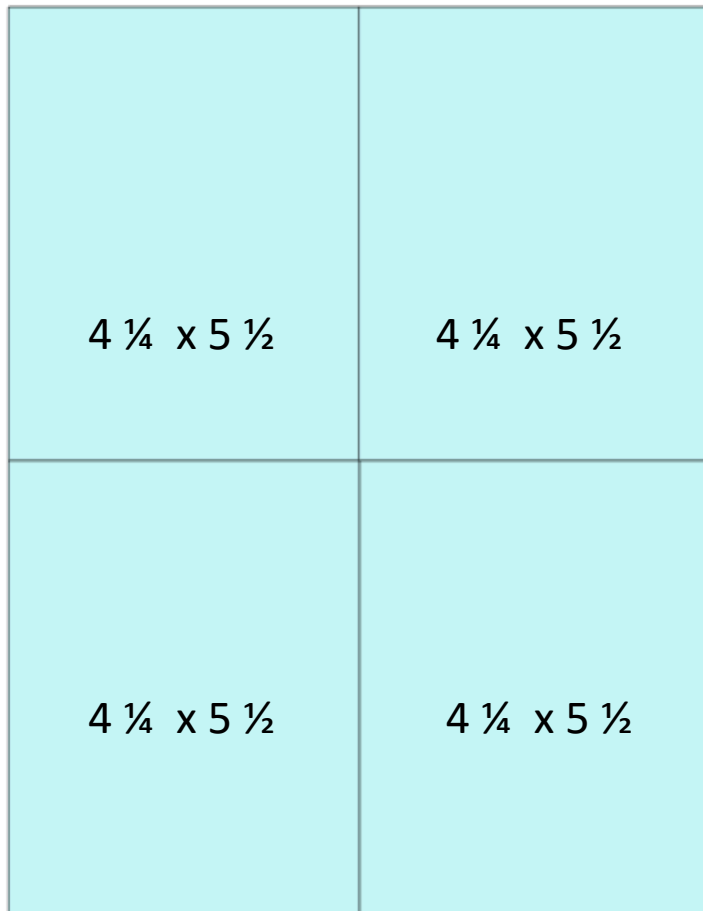


- This will give you 6 card fronts with the DSP as the top layer of your card.
- You may not need cardstock layers if you love your DSP
- Always cut smaller 3 3/4 x 5 but not bigger 😊

6x6 Designer Series Paper DSP



What about 8 ½ x 11 cardstock?



- To get the MOST use out of my cardstock, I cut mine at 4 ¼ x 5 ½



4 x 5 ¼ DSP
3 ¾ x 5 cardstock
