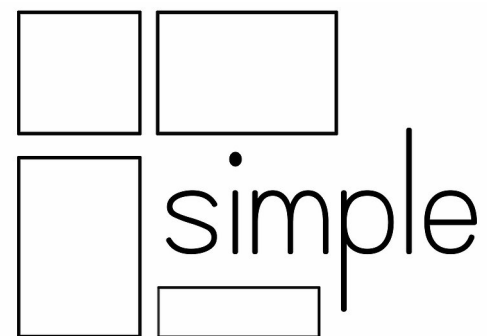

Stampin' Up! Embossing Folders, Heat and Paste

Heat Embossing

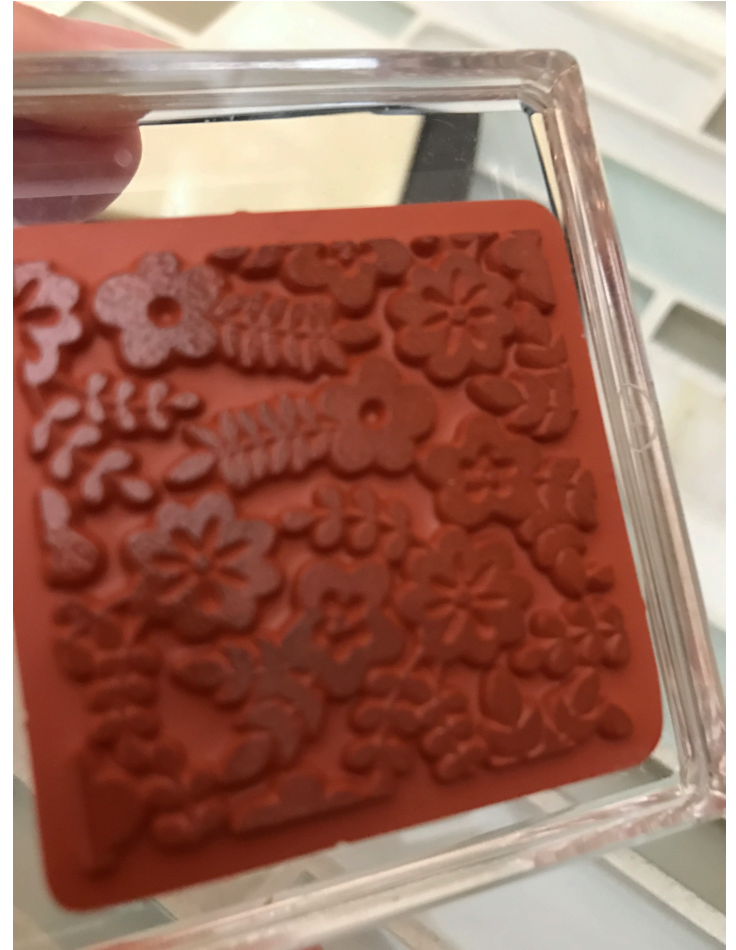
First Step: Rub area to emboss



Choose Your Stamp



Apply Versamark to stamp & stamp



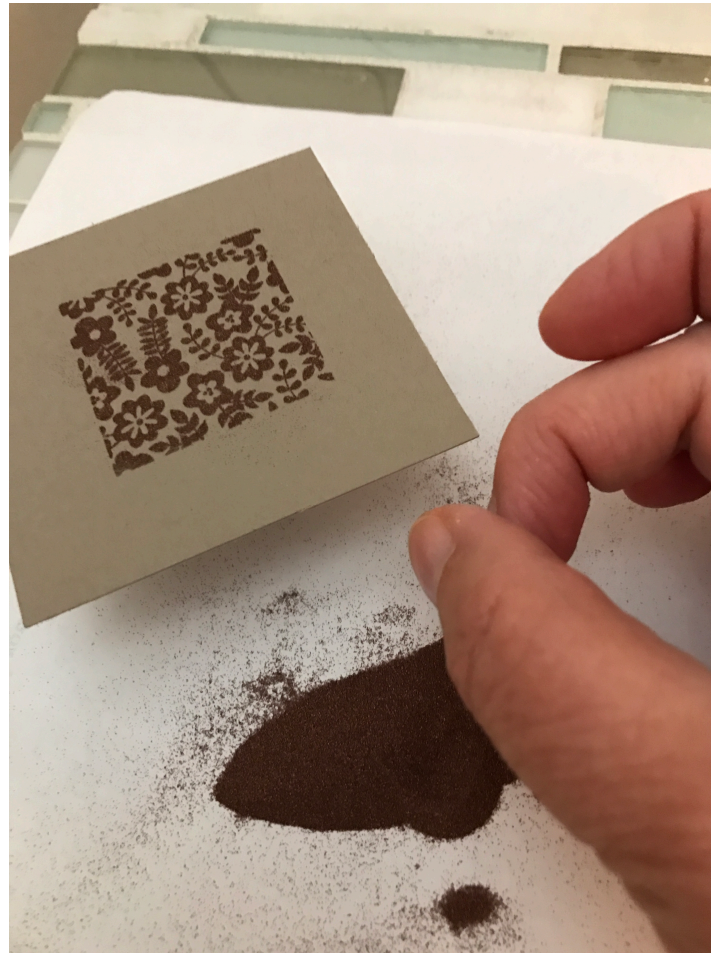
Sprinkle Embossing Powder



Pour over a sheet of white paper and then pour excess back into jar

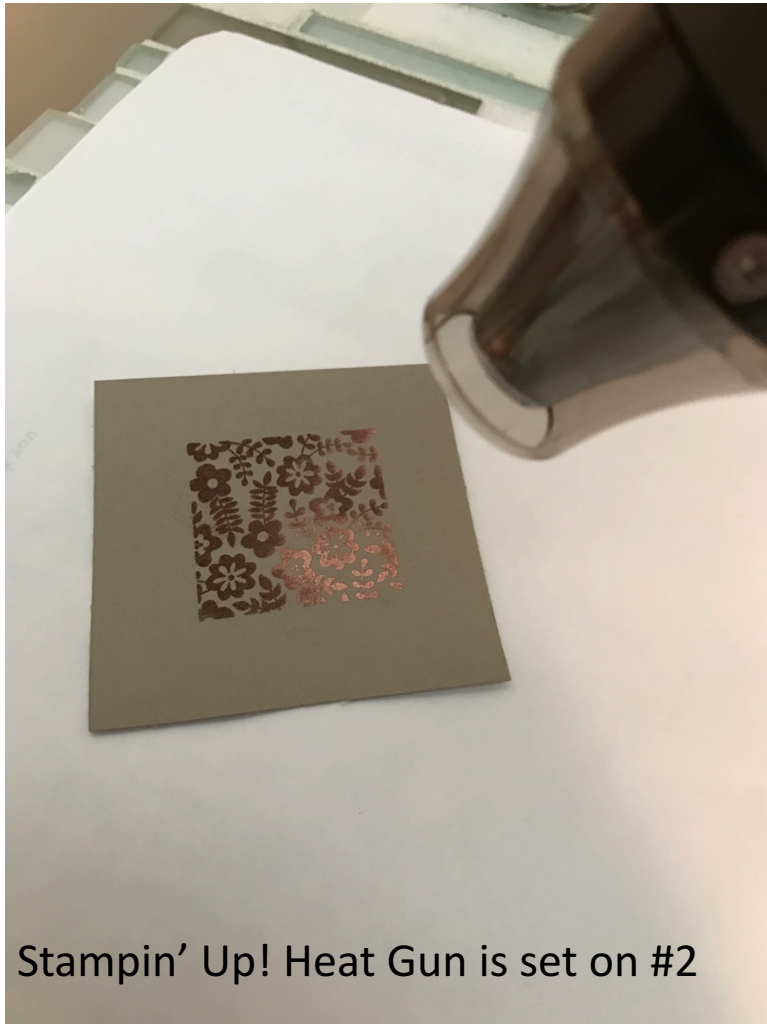
Tap off excess

A small dry paint brush may be used to clean up tiny areas



Gently flick the back with your finger

Use Heat Gun



Stampin' Up! Heat Gun is set on #2



Let Heat Gun warm up before applying to stamped area



And VOILA! Too cool right?

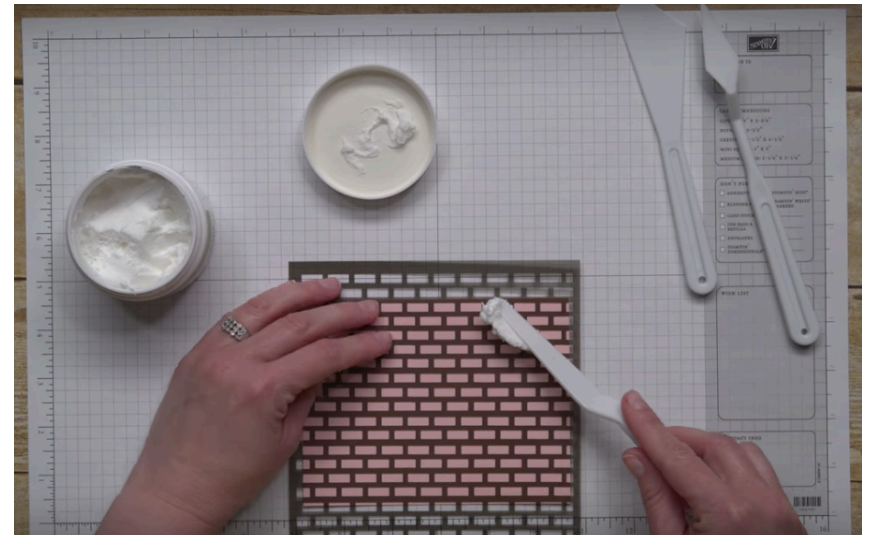
Embossing Paste

Gather your supplies

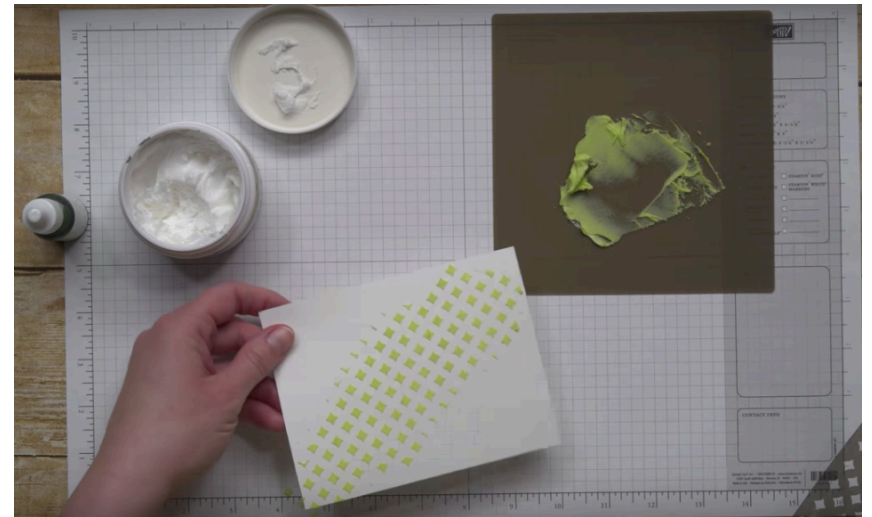
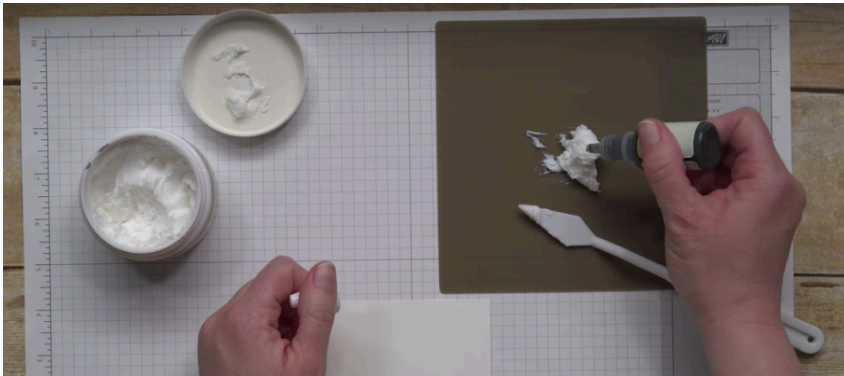
- Embossing Paste
- Palette Knives
- Decorative Masks
- Baby Wipes
- And my “must have” is a small plastic tub with warm soapy water to soak my masks in as soon as I use them
- Paper towels



It really is this easy!



Or add ink refill to color too!



Be sure to pop masks directly into soaking area as soon as you are done.

Embossing Folders

- Use your Big Shot and the basic platform and two clear plates



-except if you are using a Dynamic Textures Folder and then you will only need 1 clear plate



You will not need the “Thin Die Adapter”
