4th-15th centuries: Instigators: Byzantine emperors and Church authorities Impact: Codified discrimination, restricted civil rights

Mid 1800s-1945 and rejuvenated in the present: Instigators: Pseudo Science (19th century) Nazi regime, Adolf Hitler, Neo-Nazis today. Impact: Systematic extermination (Holocaust), 6 million Jews murdered

Red-Green-Fascist Alliance: Early 20th century onward. **Instigators**: Radical Islamic movements, far-left academia, Palestinian nationalism, Far Right Neo-Nazi (KKK) movements. **Impact**: Delegitimization of Israel, attacks on Jews, Jewish identity and statehood

MYTHS

Jews are fundamentally "other," culturally corrupt, and inherently subversive. "Ridiculous" invisible God.

04.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Greco-Roman authors (e.g., Apion, Tacitus), Hellenistic polemicists, popular folklore.

05.

IMPACT

Enslavement, exile, forced assimilation, negative stereotypes regarding Jewish separateness and untrustworthiness, social exclusion.

Blamed for deicide, demonization, loss of rights, persecution

MYTHS

Jews killed Christ (deicide); Jews are cursed and rejected by God.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Early Church Fathers (e.g., John Chrysostom, Augustine), New Testament John 8:44, Matthew 27:20-25, medieval sermons.


IMPACT

Persecution, loss of rights, blamed for deicide, demonization.



LEGAL INSTITUTIONALIZED

4th-15th centuries



Instigators and Perpetrators:

Byzantine emperors and Church authorities

Impact:

Codified discrimination, restricted civil rights, basis for European oppression.

MYTHS

Jews are a civic threat requiring segregation and economic control.

04.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Byzantine legal codes (e.g., Justinian Code), Church Councils (e.g., Lateran IV, 1215), royal edicts.

05.

IMPACT


Codified discrimination, restricted civil rights, basis for European oppression and expulsions.

Examples: Expulsions England 1290, Spain 1492

Impact:

Dhimmi status, Jizya tax, expulsions, massacres, legal discrimination

Islamic Caliphates, rulers (e.g., Charter of Omar)

03.

MYTHS

Jews are disloyal, treacherous, and inherently inferior (dhimmi status) and evil. They deny Allah.

04.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Qur'an (e.g., Surah 2:61 and 5:64), Hadiths, medieval Islamic theologians (e.g., Al-Ghazali, Ibn Hazm).

05.


IMPACT

Dhimmi status, jizya tax, expulsions, forced conversions, massacres, legal discrimination.



EUROPEAN POPULAR ANTISEMITISM

Middle Ages to Early Modern Period (c. 1000–1700s)



Instigators and Perpetrators:

Christian mobs, monarchs, Church leaders

Impact:

Pogroms, expulsions, forced conversions, blood libels, mass murders



TIME PERIOD

EUROPEAN POPULAR ANTISEMITISM

Middle Ages to Early Modern Period (1000–1700s)

02. INSTIGATORS AND PERPETRATORS

Christian mobs, Monarchs, Church leaders

03. MYTHS

Jews accused of using Christian children's blood to make matzah (blood libel); poison wells; cause plagues. Jews are aligned with the devil (have horns).

04. SOURCES OF MYTHS

Popular legends; clerical instigators; monarchs exploiting crises; inquisitorial courts.

05. IMPACT

Pogroms, expulsions, segregation, forced conversions, blood libels, mass murders.

Superstition; fabricated evidence under torture. Jews were accused of causing the Black Plague 1348-51

Instigators and Perpetrators:

Monarchies, Church, capitalist interests, revolutionary movements

Impact:

Ghettos, profession restrictions, scapegoating during economic crises

Monarchies, Church, capitalist interests, socialist revolutionary movements

03.

MYTHS

Jews manipulate financial systems; Jews are usurious capitalist exploiters as well as communist revolutionaries.

04.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Medieval monarchs indebted to Jewish financiers; nationalist economic theorists (e.g., in 19th-century France and Germany), fabricated documents "**Protocols of the Elders of Zion**".

05.

IMPACT

Property confiscation; expulsions linked to debt forgiveness, Antisemitic economic legislation, ghettos, professional restrictions, scapegoating during economic crises.

04. SOURCES OF MYTHS

Racial theorists (e.g., Gobineau), Nazi propaganda (e.g., Der Stürmer), Hitler's **Mein Kampf**

05. IMPACT

Systematic extermination (Holocaust), six million Jews murdered.

Stalinist Soviet Union, Radical Islamic movements, Far-Left academia, Palestinian liberationism, Far-Right Neo-Nazi (KKK) movements, self-denying Jews

03.

MYTHS

Zionism is colonialism; Israel is uniquely evil; Jewish lobbies control governments, the media, finance and instigate all revolutions

04.

SOURCES OF MYTHS

Soviet Cold War propaganda; Nazism, radical leftist and Islamist ideologies (e.g., Hamas Charter, 1988); United Nations platforms and certain NGOs.

05.

IMPACT

Delegitimization of Israel, attacks on Jews, Jewish identity and statehood. Demonization of Jews and the denial of their right to exist as Jews.
