

**Workshop Six: Setting Environmental Objectives & Environmental KPIs for the ISO 14001:2015**

Clause Numbers	<b>6.2.1 Environmental Objectives</b> <b>6.2.2 Planning actions to achieve environmental objectives</b>
Objectives	To understand how the organisation establishes the environmental objectives at relevant functions and levels. To understand which Environmental Indicators are used. Understand how the organisations environmental objectives can be integrated into the business processes?
Task/Output	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review the current business Environmental Objectives in light of Clauses 6.2.1 and 6.2.2</li> <li>2. Using the flip chart provided list out what indicators could be used (an indicator is a measurable representation of the condition or status of operations, management or conditions).</li> <li>3. Place the objectives into 3 levels – Strategic, Tactical and Operational (Strategic = the highest levels of the business/Tactical and Operational = specific units or functions within the business). Use the flip charts.</li> <li>4. Discuss how the objectives will be communicated.</li> <li>5. Which of the Significant Environmental Aspects should have a linked objective?</li> </ol>
Questions to consider	What audit evidence would you produce to show that the organisation has set strategic, tactical and operational environmental objectives?
	What audit evidence would you produce to show that the organisation has set environmental KPIs?
	How could you demonstrate that the objectives have been communicated to persons working under the organisations control who could have the ability to influence the achievement of the objectives?
	Are the environmental objectives consistent with the Environmental Policy?
