Now is seven hours in-the-morning.

NOTE: Jutro (morning); adverb of time - "Ujutro" (in the morning).

It's ten pm now.



Sada je deset sati uvečer.

Now is ten hours in-the-evening.

NOTE: Večer (evening); adverb of time "Uvečer" (in the evening)

Are you busy tomorrow?

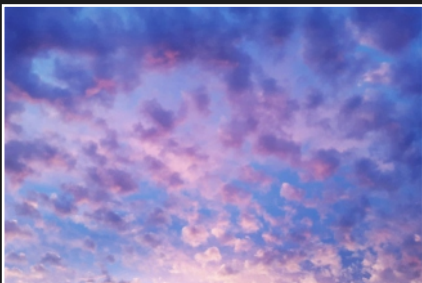


Jesi li sutra zauzet?
