Lesson I, con'f Exploring Contrasts

One way to rethink the way I'd always defined my life was to think about the contrasts.

I was given a set of glasses and was told to view the world through those lenses only.

But I wasn't born to see though someone else's lenses, I was born to discover who I am.

Through their lenses, I was told that I was condemned, that I was shameful, and that I was to fear punishment for my many sins. And I believed that for a long time!

But looking at each interaction Jesus had with others... Jesus didn't teach about guilt, in fact He teaches us not to judge or condemn others and offers forgiveness.

Jesus doesn't tell his followers that they are to be ashamed, He says that they are adopted children and heirs to the kingdom. He takes away our shame and puts us in the place of honor.

Jesus also doesn't require fear, instead, He gave his followers power and authority over the spirits of this world.

This is the place we are called to live our life from...not fear, not limiting beliefs, not narrow interpretations of what it means to obey Jesus. But from a place of trust, a place of power, and hope, and love.
