At 3:30 he takes a short rest and then continues to learn. At 4:30 his son, Rabbi Avraham Ishayahu Kinyevsky comes to his home and they discuss important issues. He gives answers to many questions. At 7:30 At 8:00 in the he prays *Maariv*. evening he goes for a short walk again. At 8:15 he eats dinner and learns with his son Rabbi A. I. Kinyevsky. At 9 he meets people for a half an hour. He learns in his room with his son Rabbi Itzahak Shaul until he finally goes to



Rabbi Michael Yehuda Leivkovitz gets up at 5:00 in the morning and starts his learning schedule. driver comes around 6:30 to his home and takes him to Yeshivat Ponovitch. He gives classes after shachrit on Sunday and Tuesday from the book Chave Addam. On Wednsday he gives a class in Mussar. At 8:00 his daughter serves him breakfast at home. At 8:15 he prepares his daily class to older students. At 11:45 he gets a ride from his student and gives a class to Avrechim. At one he prays Mincha. At 1:30 he returns home puts on Rabbenu Tam Tephilin, meets people and says Tehillim and says the parsha with targum. He eats lunch at 2:00 and takes a short rest. At 4 he learns with his grandsons, Rabbi E. Pallay and Rabbi Y.S. Korlinsky and prepares his daily class. At 7:15 he arrives in Panovitch and gives his daily class. At 8:30 he prays Maariv, returns home and accepts people for a bracha and advice. Finally at 10:30 he gives his **last** class.



Rabbi Issaac Kaduri starts his day around midnight every day. He learns until dawn. Then he goes home and rests. He walks to his Yeshiva at 7 in the morning to pray Shachrit. After the prayer, he meets people, answers questions and gives blessings to a lot of people. Around 10:30 he returns home, covered by his tallit and tephilin. He continues his learning schedule. This time he learns Talmud. He learns one page of Bavlli and one page of Yerushalmi every day. At noon he eats a little and starts to see people. At 3:30 his **helper** closes the door. Some people wait outside. After he prays Maariv, people come again and ask for his bracha. He finally goes to sleep at 11 to gain energy for the next day.
