
Lesson 1. How to greet in Korean

안녕하세요.

Hi, Hello.



The literal meaning of "안녕하세요" is 'are you doing well?' or 'Are you living in peace?" But you don't have to answer to this question by explaining how peaceful you are. you are just greeting back the same. "안녕하세요".

안녕하세요.
Hello.
저는(Name)입니다.
I'm (Name).

You don't have do fully understand this new sentence grammatically for now, but just remember it as a whole phrase used for introducing your name.

안녕하세요.

Hello.

만나서 반가워요!

Nice to meet you!

You can also use "안녕하세요" with "nice to meet you" when you get to know someone for the first time.

To a person who stays

안녕히 계세요.

Good bye! (Stay in peace!)

* 계세요 : Stay

To a person who leaves

안녕히 가세요.

Good bye! (Leave in peace!)

* 가세요 : Leave, go

You should use "안녕히 **계세요**." to the person who stays. And you should use "안녕히 **가세요.**" to person who leaves.

You can also use "안녕히 가세요" for the case that everyone is leaving to separate direction.

잘 먹었습니다.

I enjoyed the meal!!

안녕히 계세요.

Bye bye!

"잘 먹었습니다." means "I enjoyed the meal" and You say it after finishing a meal to show an appreciation on the meal.
