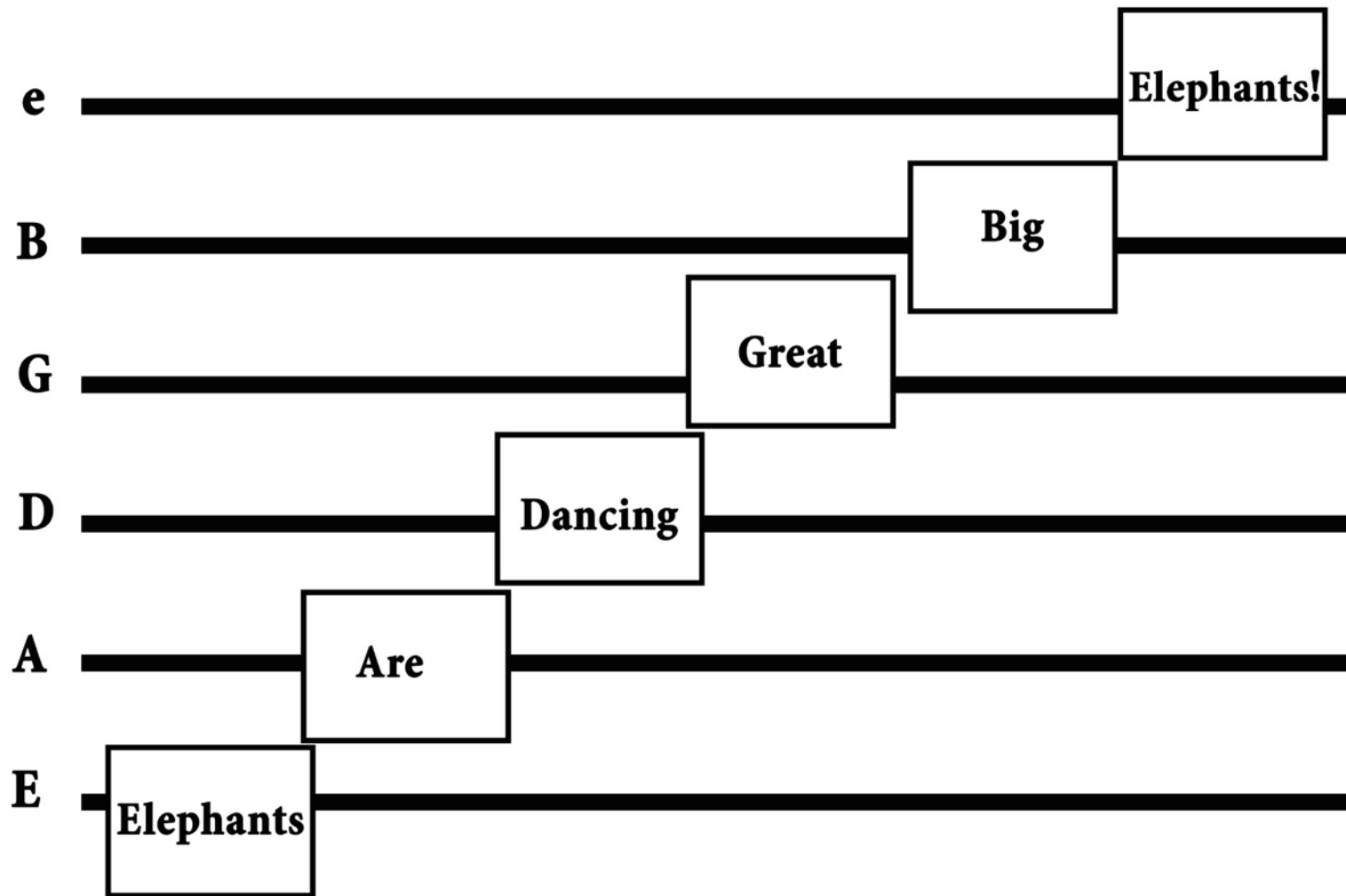

Use the note names of the guitar to make your own song. Put the words in the boxes below.
