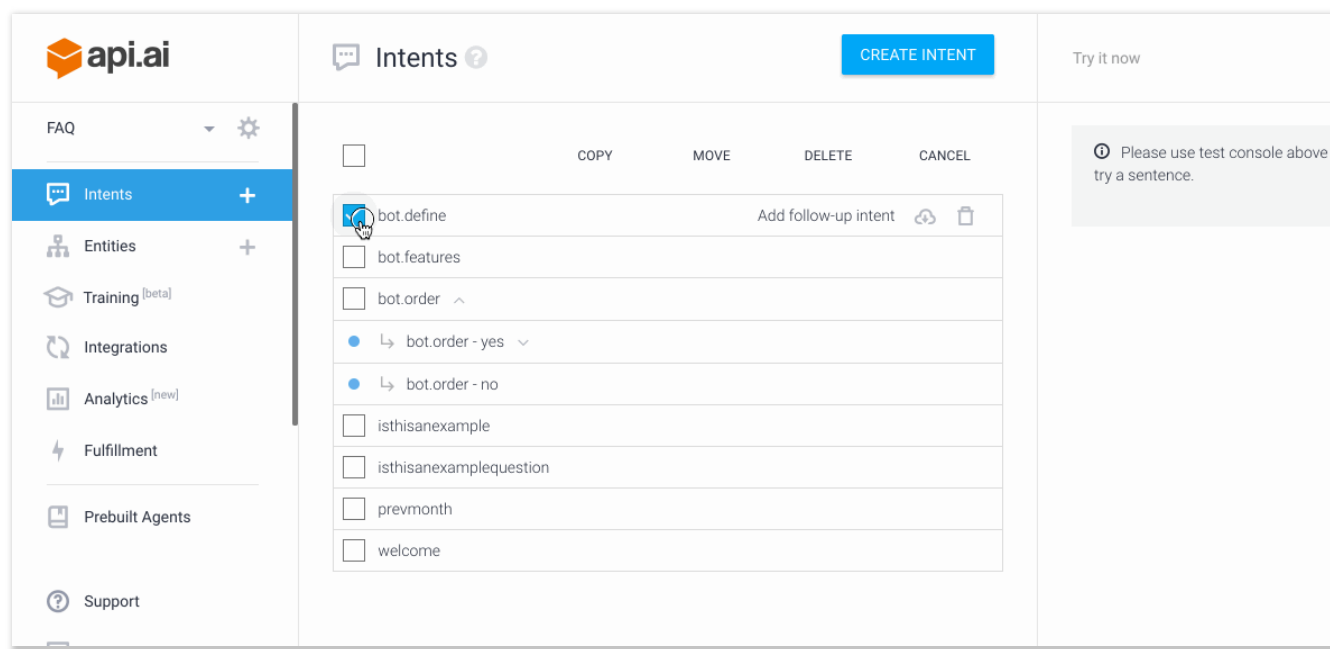
Batch operations in DialogFlow (API.AI)

API.AI has a feature which is somewhat "hidden", in my view.

It is not obvious for people when they are in the UI, and you will probably be able to see why when you see the animated GIF below.

Batch operations

So to enable batch operations like bulk delete, bulk copy, bulk move etc on your intents, you need to hover over an intent or entity in the list view. You will see a checkbox on the left of the intent. Clicking on the checkbox makes a whole bunch of other controls come into view. From there, you can choose to bulk copy/move/delete your intents and entities as appropriate.



Bonus Tip

You can actually bulk copy intents from one agent to another. An example of where this might help: you can import the prebuilt SmallTalk agent to create a new agent, and do a bulk move of all its intents into an existing agent you already have. And voila! Your existing agent just got a lot smarter! 😊
