ἀναβαίνω	I go up

ἐγείρω	I raise up	
ἐκβάλλω	I cast out	
κρίνω	I judge, decide	Critics are often judgmental.

Out of your mouth, I will judge you. (= By your words I will judge you.)

2. πῶς κρινεῖ ὁ θεὸς τὸν κόσμον;

How will God judge the world?

3. ἐν δικαιοσύνῃ κρινεῖ καὶ πολεμσεῖ.

In righteousness he will judge and make war.

4. οὐ ἔκρινά.

I did not judge.

5. ἔκρινεν τὴν πόρνην τὴν μεγάλην.

He judged the great prostitute.

6. ὁ ὄχλος ἔμεινεν.

The crowd remained.

7. καὶ γὰρ αὐτὸν ἀρῶ.

And I will raise him.

8. αὐτὸς ἔμεινεν ἐν τῇ Γαλιλαίᾳ.

He stayed in Galilee.

9. ἐμείναμεν ἡμέραν μίαν παρ' αὐτοῖς.

We stayed one day with them.

10. ἀποστελῶ αὐτοὺς λιμὸν καὶ θάνατον.

I will send them famine and death.
