- •This resource was created so that schools who were using the units of study in multiple grades could have additional suggested text titles for the lessons.
- •Of course, teachers can choose any texts they have available that are related to the specific genre they are teaching.
- •The texts used during interactive read alouds, which will become mentor texts during the mini lessons, can be any text that is appropriate for that particular genre.
 - •For example, if you are teaching the personal narrative unit, you might search for mentor texts in your school library that are memoirs.
- *Once you have decided on your mentor texts in advance of teaching the unit, then you can go ahead and begin reading the texts to your class.
 - •This will prepare them for the learning they will be doing during the unit because you will reference whatever mentor texts you read as you teach each mini lesson.
- •The texts suggested in this resource are simply additional suggestions to the texts used as examples in the units of study resources.
- •The lessons can be taught at different levels of intensity, from grades 2-6. many of the lessons are similar across grade levels, but the Common Core State Standards always match each particular grade.
- •l intentionally made the lessons similar for several reasons:
 - •So that schools using the lessons in more than one grade can create a common language that is familiar for students from one year to the next.
 - •Because, after studying the Common Core State Standards very carefully, I noticed that several of the standards were nearly the same from one grade to the next.
 - •So that the lessons would be challenging enough for all students. I reasoned that teachers can always alter the content to a less difficult degree, or take more time, if necessary for their students.
