



# Stitched birds

## Supplies required

### Materials required

- Felt in one or two main colours. (A piece about 15x15cm will be enough to make a bird. But this is a great place to use scraps of felt and fabrics, so have some of those on hand too.)
- Felt scraps in one or two contrasting colours
- Embroidery threads (whatever you prefer working with)
- Wire - florist wire or craft wire (22 - 24 gauge, 22 gauge is stronger but harder to bend)
- Stuffing (I use scrap yarn, but whatever stuffing you prefer)

### Tools required

- Scissors (you will be cutting fabric, card and thread)
- Needles for embroidery and hand sewing
- Pliers and wire cutters are great if you have them (an old pair of scissors are fine if you don't)
- Clips or pins
- Ruler

### Optional extras

- Beads, sequins, ribbons (optional embellishments)
- Ribbons, ricrac, decorative trim, old doilies (optional embellishments)
- Light card (for if you use templates)
- Tweezers (helpful for stuffing)
- Sewing thread
