We will send you an invite to the group shortly after you sign up for Write Out Loud so look out for the request.

Just a few things to remember inside the group.

Posting your work

• Remember that you should write "© Copyright and your name and year" on any work you have submitted on the Facebook page. This is a reminder for everyone that you are the owner of the work.

Responding to work is a reciprocal process and remember that everyone's responses are subjective. Here are a few pointers for responding:

- How do you critically respond to work
- Please deliver your response with respect and sensitivity.
- Please have respect for the writers culture.
- Please keep your response focussed on the craft of the writing rather than 'I think you should do this" ie. offering your subjective opinions on what 'should' happen. A good way to do this is to only ASK QUESTIONS that prompt the writer to think about their work afresh.
- Please check that your response comes from a place of "when I read this I felt" knowing that your response to the work is subjective and may not be right or wrong.
- It is best not to offer plot solutions, but again asking questions about where the story is going will help the writer to understand.
- When you read feedback to your work, remember that it is subjective and may not be where you are coming from.
- Rude/abusive comments are not useful and will be taken down by the moderator.
