- Begin in Adobe Photoshop.
- Open the scrapbook page (File > Open) that you created in this class.

### Create a Custom Shadow

- In the Layers panel, click on the Pattern Paper Anchor group to make it active and then click on the arrow to twirl it open.
- Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the Effects icon of the shape layer and choose Create Layer.
- Click on the custom shadow layer to make it active.

### Smudge the Shadow

- Press Ctrl + (Mac: Cmd +) to zoom in. To reposition the zoom, hold down the Space Bar and click and drag on the document.
- Get the Smudge tool.

- In the Tool Options, open the Brush Picker. Choose a Soft Round brush from the Legacy > Default Brushes. Set the Mode to Normal and the Strength to 50%. Uncheck Sample All Layers and Finger Painting. Set the Size to 700 px.
- On the document, click and drag very slightly on the custom shadow to smudge it.



- In the Layers panel, lower the Fill of the custom shadow layer to 40%.

#### Save the Page

- In the Layers panel, click on the arrow of the anchor group to close it.
- Save the page (File > Save).
