Quickly Remove Small Objects in a Photo with Content-Aware

What is Content-Aware?

- Content-Aware seamlessly fills a selected portion of an image with similar image content from surrounding parts of the photo.

How To Use Content-Aware

- Use the Lasso Tool to select a portion of the image to remove.
- In the Menu Bar, choose Edit > Fill Selection. (PS: Choose Edit > Fill.)
- In the dialog box, set the Use to Content-Aware. (PS: Set the Contents to Content-Aware.) Set the Blending Mode to Normal, the Opacity to 100%, and uncheck Preserve Transparency. (PS: check the Color Adaptation option.) Click OK.
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to deselect.

Additional Tips:

- Only try to replace small objects from the image.
- Your initial selection should extend slightly beyond the object that you want to remove.
- If you don't like the results, undo (Ctrl/Cmd Z) and start over.
