DYADS THAT SHOW G MAJOR

DYADS THAT SHOW A MINOR

RANDOM DYADS IN A PENTATONIC MINOR SCALE

- *Technically, to be classified a "chord" we must have at least 3 notes. Dyads are basically 2-note chords.
- *Also called double-stops (from bowed instruments, violin, cello, etc.)
- *Can be made up of chord tones to create bits of harmony, or with any notes at all to improvise.
- *On flatpicking guitar, dyads are on adjacent strings, although, they can skip strings for hybrid & fingerstyle.
