PREPOSITIONS OF TIME - AT, IN, ON

We use:

- at for a **PRECISE TIME**
- in for **MONTHS, YEARS, CENTURIES** and **LONG PERIODS**
- on for **DAYS** and **DATES**

Examples:

I wake up at 7am.

She was born in January.

They work on Sunday.



PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE - AT, IN, ON

We use:

- at for **EXACT POSITION**
- in for whenever something is **inside something**
- on for whenever something is **attached to or touching something**

Examples:

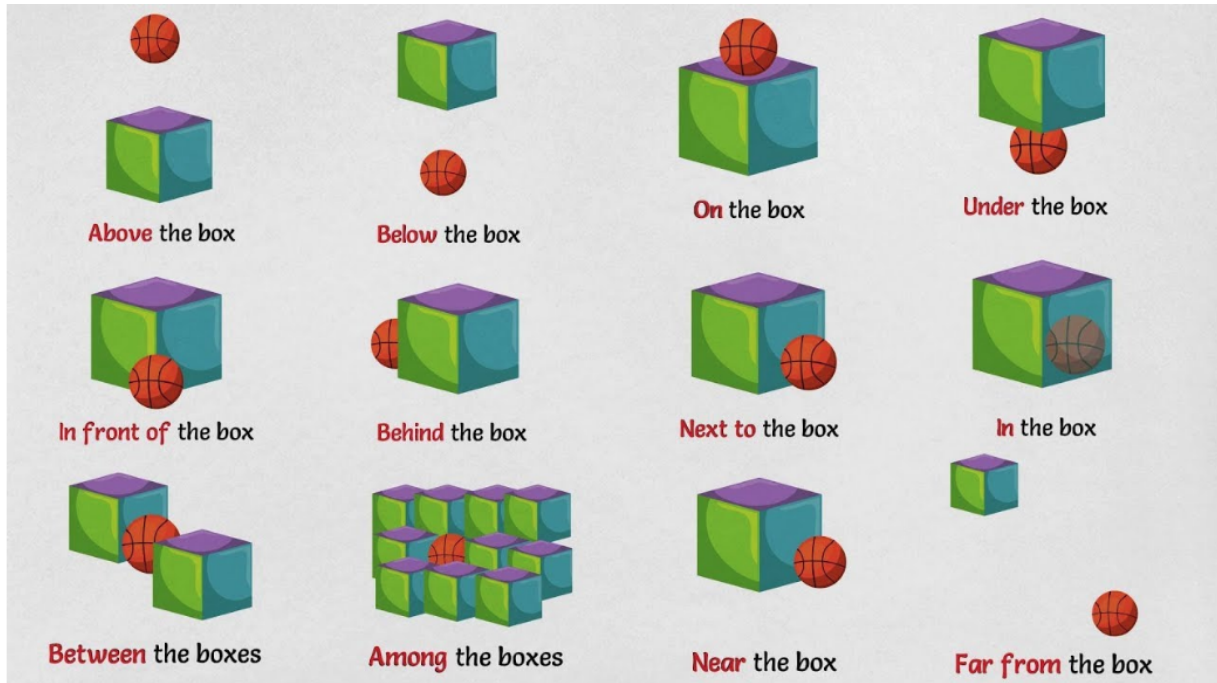
He is at the gym.

We are in the living room.

The clock is on the wall.



OTHER PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE:



For/since

For is used when specifying the amount of time (how long):

Example:

I've had this car for 10 years.

Since is used when specifying the starting point:

Example:

I've had this car since 2008.

BY

By can have many different meanings:

- near to or next to:

There is a house **by** the lake.

- within the extent or period of:

They work **by** day.

- not later than; at or before:

Deliver the assignment **by** Wednesday.



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
