This Certification Program fulfills Courageous Conversation's intent to enable widespread implementation of the Protocol for Courageous Conversations About Race™ (CCAR) to assist individuals and organizations to begin to successfully create equitable environments and communities. The Affiliate Program provides a certification process to develop individuals to lead CCAR™ with others in order to build system capacity and sustainability for racial equity transformation. The virtual certification course combines online learning, video conferencing, and field practice. Coaching is offered to Affiliates for up to one year after completing the certification course.

# DETAILING THE CCAR AFFILIATE CERTIFICATION PROCESS

#### **PRE-REQUISITES**

- Attend full two-day Beyond Diversity seminar at a PEG summit, regional, or city offering.
- (Optional) Two-day Beyond Diversity II Seminar.
- Read Courageous Conversations About Race: A Field Guide for Achieving Equity in Schools, by G. E. Singleton (2015).

#### **TECHNOLOGY**

- Participation in this certification program requires extensive online training and group interaction.
- Candidates must be proficient in online classroom tools, webinars, and videos.

#### SELECTION

 Selected candidates should exhibit outstanding leadership and facilitation skills, capacity for self-development and direct implementation of continuous feedback.

#### PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Attend an online orientation webinar meeting with community agency or individual Affiliate candidate and PEG Affiliate Program Manager.
- Participate in Affiliate CCAR Practitioner Certification. This is a six-week course with two one-hour live webinars and one-live Saturday training.
- Participate in monthly CCAR Practice and live webinars for one year.

#### **FEEDBACK**

- Participants must be open to intensive coaching.
- This courageous self-reflection will excavate socialized racial histories to develop a new racial consciousness required for CCARTM facilitation.

#### RECERTIFICATION

 Remaining current and connected to the Protocol language and delivery, biannual recertification is required to maintain consistency with our proprietary materials content and processes.
