COVENANT PRAYER WITH THE NAMES OF GOD

Ps 75:1 "WE GIVE praise and thanks to You, O God, we praise and give thanks; Your wondrous works declare that Your Name is near and **they who invoke Your Name** rehearse Your wonders."

THIS IS A PRAYER TO MAKE A COVENANT WITH THE LIVING GOD. WE NEED TO LEARN THE SECRET TO LIVE IN THE NAME OF THE LORD AND TO STAND ON THE WORD OF GOD TO BE VICTORIOUS IN EVERY SITUATION.

Loving God and Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus Christ. You say in John 3 verse 16 that You have loved the world so much, that You gave Your only Son, that whoever believes in Jesus should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

Father, You say in **Hebrews 4 verse 16** that I can approach Your throne of grace with confidence, in order to receive mercy and grace, and to help me in a time of need. Father, I love You very much, because You have loved me first.

Father I thank You That You say in **Jeremiah 29 verse 11** that Your thoughts for me is to give me a future and a hope. Thoughts of peace and not of evil.

Lord Jesus Christ, I proclaim that You are the Son of the living God, the Anointed One and the High Priest of the New Testament. Your throne is established on justice and righteousness.

The Word says in **Daniel 7 and 10** that Your throne is like a fiery flame and s wheels a burning fire. Upon this magnificent throne sits Jesus Christ, who is clothed in a garment, white as snow, whose loins are girded with pure gold. Your Body is a beryl and Your face has the appearance of lightning. Your hair is like pure white wool.

Your eyes are like flaming torches, Your arms and feet are like glowing burnished bronze.

And the sound of Your words are like the roaring of the sea and like the noise of a multitude. I worship You. You are altogether lovely and powerful.

Hebrews 7 verse 22 says that You are the surety and the guarantee of the better Covenant, a Covenant of mercy. You have delivered me from the power of darkness and translated me into Your kingdom of love. I am now saved and sanctified by Your precious Blood. The moment that You died for me on the cross, the curtain in the temple was torn in two. I thank You that You gave me access into the Most Holy. You are the way to the Father. You are the Light and the Way, the Truth and the Life. You are the Lion of Judah, the Prince of Peace and the bright Morning Star. You are the Rose of Sharon and the Lily of the valleys. I worship You.

God the Holy Spirit, I welcome You once again into my heart and into my life. I honour You for Your power and for Your tenderness. Please forgive me for all the situations wherein I have grieved You. You are the Spirit of Mercy and You came to me while I was still unsaved. You are the Spirit of Life and gave me new life, the day when I gave my heart to Jesus. You are the Spirit of Adoption to Your children, and You shed the love of the Father abroad into my heart.

LORD, teach me how to worship You in Spirit and in Truth. (John 4 V 24) I pray in the Name of Jesus that all nine the gifts of the Holy Spirit will work through me, like rivers of living water. I pray that the Holy Spirit will minister life and quickening power to all the people as You release it. I ask in the Name of Jesus Christ for the full operation of the Holy Spirit in my life. The Spirit without measure.

Father, I pray in the Name of Jesus that You will baptize me with the Holy Spirit and with His fire. (Matthew 3 V 11)
I pray for the Spirit of Truth (1 John 4V6), the Spirit of Wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD. (Isaiah 11 V 2)

Father, I pray for the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1 V 17). The Spirit of power, love and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1 V 7). The Spirit of Faith (2 Cor 4V13), The Spirit of Glory and of God (1 Peter 4V14), The Spirit of Promise (Ephesians I V13) and for the Spirit of Unity (Ephesians 4V3).

Holy Spirit, You are my helper, the One who instructs me, warns me and leads me. You comfort me and strengthen me. Please change me so that I can become more like Jesus.

FATHER, I COME TO YOU LIKE A CHILD AND I DEDICATE MY LIFE TO YOU. GOD THE FATHER, GOD THE SON, LORD JESUS CHRIST, AND GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT; I SUBMIT MYSELF TO YOUR AUTHORITY AND I AM JOINING MYSELF TO YOU, I MAKE A PERPETUAL COVENANT WITH YOU ACCORDING TO JEREMIAH 50 VERSE 5. I DO THIS IN THE NAME OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST.

IN THIS COVENANT I GIVE YOU MY WHOLE EXISTENCE, MY SPIRIT, SOUL AND BODY, MY FAMILY, MINISTRY, OCCUPATION, STUDIES AND MY FUTURE.

Father, I ask for the full inheritance of Your perfect will for my life here on earth, as it is in Heaven according to **2 Timothy 1 V 9** and **Ephesians 2 V 10**.

Let Your kingdom come, for I desire to please You. I ask that You will reveal to me with crystal clarity my prophetic blue-print calling of my life. I pray that You will lead me into the full fulfillment of it.

Father please be merciful unto me and take me into Your vision for my life, my ministry and my career. Reveal it to my heart, mind and understanding through the precious Holy Spirit. **Proverbs 29V18** says that where there is no vision the people perish.

Father, I pray according to **Zechariah 9 verse 11 to 17** that because of the Blood of the Covenant, You will redeem me from the waterless pit and restore double unto me. I pray that You will deliver me and make me like a sword in Your Mighty Hand. I ask that You that You will make me a jewel of Your crown.

Father God, I thank You that the LORD Jesus became a curse on the cross for me. **Galatians 3 verse 13** says that Jesus broke the curse of the law, so that I can became a joint-heir of the blessings of Abraham. **Galatians 3 verse 29** says that if I am in Christ, then I am also of Abraham's seed and a heir according to the promise.

Father, I pray that You will bless me with the blessings of the Abrahamic covenant according to Deuteronomy 28 verse 1-14:

- 1 I pray that You will set me high above all the nations of the earth.
- 2 I pray that all these blessings shall come upon me and overtake me, because I obey Your voice.
- 3 I pray that You will bless me in the city and in the country.
- 4 I pray that You will bless the fruit of my body, the produce of my ground and the increase of my herds, the increase of my cattle and the offspring of my flocks.
- 5 I pray that You will bless my basket and my kneading bowl.
- 6 I pray that You will bless me when I come in and bless me when I go out. On all the roads and highways.
- 7 I pray that You will cause my enemies who raise against me, to be defeated before my face; so that they who come against me in one way, will flee in seven ways before me.
- 8 I pray that You will command Your blessings in my storehouses and in all to which I set my hand to, in the land that You have given me.
- 9 I pray that You will establish me to Yourself as a holy people. I make a covenant to keep Your commandments and to walk in Your ways.
- 10 I pray that all the people of the earth will see that I am called by Your Name.

- 11 I pray that You will grant me plenty of goods, in the fruit of my body, in the increase of my livestock and in the produce of my ground.
- 12 Father, I pray that You will open Your good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to my land in its season, and to bless all the work of my hands. I pray that I shall not have to borrow money, but become able to lend to many nations.
- 13 I pray that You will make me the head and not the tail. That I will go up and not down.
- 14 I make a covenant to obey You and Your Holy Word. I proclaim that I shall not turn aside from any of Your Words, neither to the left nor to the right hand, to go after other gods to serve them.

Father, Your identity and Your very character is reflected in the rich meanings of your different Names of redemption.

Proverbs 18 verse 10 says that the Name of the LORD is a strong tower, the righteous run into it and they are safe.

Isaiah 63 verse 16 says: You, O LORD, are our Father; Our Redeemer from Everlasting is Your Name. The LORD Jesus prayed in **John 17 verse 11** for us before He died: Father, I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your Name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.

Father in Heaven, I make an perpetual covenant with You and with Your different Names of redemption:

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH ELihoenai**. My eyes are focused towards **YAHWEH**.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH EL Elyon.**You are the LORD, the **Most High God.**I worship You and submit myself to Your authority.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH Elohim**.
You are the **Creator of the heavens and the earth**.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH Hosenu**. Father, you are **my Maker**.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH Adonai.
You are My LORD and my Master.
I make a covenant to be obedient to You.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH Elohim Melek.
Father, You are the Great King. I honour You and worship You.
Father in Heaven, Hallowed be Your Name.
Let Your kingdom come in my life.
On earth as it is in Heaven. (Matthew 6V10)
Teach me to press into the Kingdom. (Luke 16V 16)
I ask that You will help me to become violent in prayer according to Matthew 11 verse 12 to take the Kingdom by force.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH Elohim Eloah.**You are the **One and only true God.**I worship You, and submit myself to Your authority.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH Elohim Olam**. You are an **Everlasting God**.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH EL Shamayim.

You own the whole earth and the fullness thereof.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH EL Roi.

You are the All-Seeing God.

LORD, I pray according to **Ephesians 1 V 18** for the enlightening of my eyes of understanding; that I may know what is the hope of my calling and the riches of my inheritance.

I make a covenant with **YAHWEH ELishama** You are the **God who hears everything.**I pray for the opening of my spiritual ears.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH Elohim Qodesh.

You are a Holy God. I worship You.

Father I ask You to lead me on the Highway of Holiness according to **Isaiah 35 verse 8**.

I confess all involvement with the occult and all sexual sins and immoralities outside the holy marriage covenant. LORD Jesus, I ask You to sanctify me with Your Precious Blood. I pray that Your cross and Your Blood will come between me and these sins.

Psalm 104 V 1-2 says: O LORD, my God, You are very great! You are clothed with honour and majesty, Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment.

Proverbs 4V18 says that the path of the righteous is like the rising sun, That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.

I make a covenant with YAHWEH Elohim Emeth.

You are the **God of Truth.**

Father, I make a covenant that I will read and receive Your Word regularly with a humble spirit, for it is able to save my soul, for it is the end of faith. (James 1 V 21)

I ask that You will to set me free in the truth of Your Word.

(John 8 V 32)

Acts 20 verse 32 says that the Word will build me up and give me an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

THE BLOOD OF JESUS

LIFE IN THE BLOOD

John 6:53-56 "53 And Jesus said to them, I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, you cannot have any life in you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood [unless you appropriate His life and the saving merit of His blood]. 54 He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood has (possesses now) eternal life, and I will raise him up [from the dead] on the last day.

55 For My flesh is true and genuine food, and My blood is true and genuine drink. 56 He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood dwells continually in Me, and I [in like manner dwell continually] in him."

1 Cor. 10:16 "16 The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper] upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in drinking it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the blood of Christ (the Messiah)? The bread which we break, does it not mean [that in eating it] we participate in and share a fellowship (a communion) in the body of Christ?"

The drinking of the Blood of the Lord Jesus is the subject brought before us in these words. Just as water has a two-fold effect, so is it also with this Holy Blood.

When water is used for **washing** it cleanses, but if we **drink** it we are refreshed and revived. He who desires to know the full power of the Blood of Jesus must be taught by Him what the blessing of drinking the Blood is. Everyone knows the difference there is between **washing** and **drinking**. Necessary and very pleasant as it is to use water for cleansing, it is much more necessary and reviving to drink it. Without its cleansing, it is not possible to live as we ought; but without drinking we cannot live at all. It is only by drinking that we enjoy the full benefit of its power to sustain life.

Without drinking the Blood of the Son of God- is without the most hearty appropriation of it--- life cannot be obtained.

To many there is something unpleasant in the phrase "drinking the Blood of the Son of Man," but it was still more disagreeable to the Jews, for the use of blood was forbidden by the law of Moses, under severe penalties. When Jesus spoke of "drinking His Blood," it naturally annoyed them-but it was an unspeakable offence to their religious feelings. Our Lord, we may be sure, would not have used the phrase. had He been able otherwise to make plain to them, and to us, the deepest and most glorious truths concerning salvation by the Blood.

In seeking to become partakers of the salvation here spoken of, as "DRINKING THE BLOOD OF OUR LORD" let us endeavour to understand:

I. WHAT THE BLESSING IS WHICH IS DESCRIBED AS "DRINKING THE BLOOD."

- II. HOW THIS BLESSING IS WROUGHT OUT IN US.
- III. WHAT SHOULD BE OUR ATTITUDE TOWARDS IT.

I. WHAT THE BLESSING IS WHICH IS DESCRIBED AS "DRINKING THE BLOOD."

We saw just now that drinking expresses a much more intimate connection with water than washing, and hence produces a more powerful effect. There is a blessing in the fellowship with the Blood of Jesus which goes mach farther than CLEANSING, or SANCTIFICATION; or rather we are enabled to see how far reaching is the influence of the blessing indicated by this phrase.

Not only must the Blood do something FOR us, by placing us in a new relationship to God; but it must do something IN us, entirely renewing us within. It is to this that the words of the Lord Jesus draw our attention when He says: "...you cannot have any life in you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood."

Our Lord distinguishes two kinds of life. The Jews, there, in His presence, had a natural life of body and soul. Many among them were devout, well intentioned men, but He said they had **no life** in them unless they "eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood."

They needed another life, a new, Heavenly life, which He possessed and which He could impart. All creature life must obtain nourishment outside of itself. The natural life was naturally nourished, by bread and water. The Heavenly life must be nourished by Heavenly food and drink, by Jesus Himself. "... You cannot have any life in you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood." Nothing less must become ours, than His life the life that He, as Son of Man, lived on earth.

Our Lord emphasised this still more strongly in words which follow, in which He again explained what the nature of that life is: "He who feeds on My flesh and DRINKS MY BLOOD has (possesses now) eternal life, and I will raise him up [from the dead] on the last day." Eternal life is the life of God. Our Lord came to earth, in the first place, to reveal that eternal life in the flesh and then to communicate it to us who are in the flesh.

In Him we see the eternal life dwelling in its Divine Power, in a Body of flesh; which was taken up into Heaven. He tells us that those who eat His flesh and drink His Blood, who partake of His Body as their sustenance, will experience also in their own bodies the power of eternal life. "I will raise him up at the last day." The marvel of the eternal life in Christ is that it was eternal life in a human body.

We must be partakers of that Body, not less than in the activities of His Spirit, then our body, also, possessing that life, will one day be raised from the dead.

Our Lord said: "My flesh is meat indeed and MY BLOOD is drink indeed." The word translated "indeed" here is the same as that He used when He spoke His parable of the True Vine, "I am the True (the indeed) Vine," thus indicating the difference; between what was only **a symbol** and what is **actual truth**. Earthly food is no REAL food, for it imparts no real life.

The one True food is the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ which imparts and sustains life and that in no shadowy or merely symbolical manner. No, this word so frequently repeated, indicates that in a full and real sense the flesh and Blood of the Lord Jesus are the food by which eternal life is nourished and sustained in us: "My flesh is meat INDEED, and My Blood is drink INDEED."

In order to point out the reality and power of this food our Lord added: "He that eateth my flesh and drinketh my blood dwelleth in me and I in him."

Nourishment by His flesh and blood effects the most perfect union with Him. This is the reason that His flesh and blood have such power of eternal life. Our Lord declares here, that those who believe in Him are to experience not only certain influences from Him in their hearts, but are to be brought into the most close and abiding union with Him. "He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood dwells continually in Me, and I [in like manner dwell continually] in him "

This then is the blessing of drinking the Blood of the Son of Man-becoming one with Him: becoming a partaker of the Divine Nature in Him. How real this union is may be seen from the words which follow: "Just as the living Father sent Me and I live by (through, because of) the Father, even so whoever continues to feed on Me [whoever takes Me for his food and is nourished by Me] shall [in his turn] live through and because of Me." (John 6:57)

Nothing save the union which exists between our Lord and the Father, can serve as a type of our union with Him. Just as in the invisible. Divine Nature, the two Persons are Truly One, so man becomes one with Jesus; the union is just as real as that in the Divine Nature only with this difference, that as human nature cannot exist apart from the body, this union includes the body also. Our Lord "prepared for Himself" a Body into which He took up a human body.

This body became by the Body and Blood of Jesus a sharer in eternal life, in the life of our Lord Himself. Those who desire to receive fullness of this blessing must be careful to enjoy all that the Scripture offers them in the Holy, mysterious expression "to drink the Blood of Christ".

We shall now try to understand:

II. HOW THIS BLESSING IS WROUGHT OUT IN US: or what the "drinking of the Blood of Jesus" really is.

The first idea that here presents itself is that "drinking" indicates the deep, true appropriation in our spirit, by faith, of all we understand concerning the power of the Blood.

We speak sometimes of "drinking in" the words of a speaker, when we heartily give ourselves up to listen and receive them. So when the heart of anyone is filled with a sense of the preciousness and Power of the Blood; when he with real joy, is lost in the contemplation of it: when he, with wholehearted faith, takes it for himself, and seeks to be convinced in his inner being of the life-giving power of that Blood then it may be rightly said that he "drinks the Blood of Jesus." All that faith enables him to see of REDEMPTION, of CLEANSNG, of SANCTIFICATION by the Blood he absorbs into the depths of his soul.

There is a deep truth in this representation, and it gives us a very glorious demonstration of the way in which the full blessing by the blood may be obtained. And yet it is certain that our Lord intended something more than this by so repeatedly making use of the expression about "eating His Flesh and drinking His Blood." What this further truth is becomes clear by His institution of THE LORD'S SUPPER.

For although our Saviour did not actually deal with that Supper when He taught in Capernaum, yet He spoke on the subject of which later or The Supper was made the visible confirmation. In the Reformed Churches there are two aspects of viewing the Holy Supper. According to one which is called after the name of the Reformer Zwingli, the bread and wine in the Supper are merely tokens, or representations of spiritual truth, to teach us that JUST AS, AND AS SURE AS, bread and wine when eaten or drunk, nourish and revive, so surely – and even more surely – the Body and Blood recognised and appropriated by faith, nourish and quicken the soul.

According to the other view which bears the name of Calvin, there is something more than this in the eating of the Supper. He teaches that in a hidden and incomprehensible way, but yet really, we, through the Holy Spirit, become so nourished by the Body and Blood of Jesus in Heaven, that even our body, through the power of His Body, becomes a partaker in the power of eternal life.

Hence Calvin connects the resurrection of the Body with the eating of Christ's Body in the Supper. He writes thus: "The Bodily presence which the Sacrament demands is such, and exercises such a power here (in the Supper) that it becomes not only the undoubted assurance in our spirit of eternal life, but also assures the immortality of the flesh.

If anyone asks me how this can be, I am not ashamed to acknowledge that it is a mystery too high for my spirit to comprehend, or my words to express. I feel it more than I can understand it."

"It may seem incredible indeed that the flesh of Christ should reach us from such immense local distance so as to become our food. But we must remember how far the power of the Holy Spirit transcends all our senses. Let faith then embrace what the understanding cannot grasp, namely: The sacred communication of His flesh and Blood by which Christ transfuses His life into us, just as if it penetrated our bones and marrow."

The communion of the flesh and Blood of Christ is necessary for all who desire to inherit eternal life.

The Apostle says: "The Church ... is His Body " (Eph. 1:23);

"He is the Head, Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One). For because of Him the whole body (the church, in all its various parts), closely joined and firmly knit together by the joints and ligaments with which it is supplied, when each part [with power adapted to its need] is working properly [in all its functions], grows to full maturity, building itself up in love" (Eph. 4:15,16).

Our bodies are members of Christ (2 Cor. 4:15, 16). We see that all this cannot take place if He is not attached to us in body and spirit.

The Apostle again makes use of a glorious expression, "We are members of His Body, of His Flesh and of His Bones."

Then He cries out," The mystery is great" It would therefore be folly not to recognize the communion of believers in the Body and Blood of the Lord; a communion which the Apostle esteemed so great that he wondered at it, rather than explained it.

There is something more in the Supper than simply the believer appropriating the redemptive work of Christ.

What is it then to eat the crucified Body of Christ and to drink His shed Blood?

The answer is, " It is not only to embrace with a believing heart all the sufferings and death of Christ and thereby to receive pardon of sin and eternal life; but also, besides that, to become more and more united to His sacred Body, by the Holy Spirit who dwells at once both in Christ and in us; so that we, though Christ is in Heaven and we on earth, are, notwithstanding, flesh of His flesh, and bone of His bones; and we live and are governed for ever by one Spirit."

In the creation of man, the remarkable thing which should distinguish him from the spirits which God had previously created, and which should make man the crowning work of God's wisdom and power was, that he should reveal the life of the spirit and the glory of God in a body formed out of dust. Through the body, lust and sin came into the world. Full redemption is designed to deliver the body, and to make it God's abode.

Redemption will be perfect and God's purpose accomplished only then. This was the purpose for which the Lord Jesus came in the flesh and in Him dwelt "all the fullness of the Godhead bodily."

For this He bore our sins in His body on the tree, and by His death and resurrection He delivered the body, as well as the spirit, from the power of sin and death. As the First Fruits of this redemption, we are now One Body, as well as one Spirit, with Him.

We are of His Body, of His Flesh, and of His Bones. It is because of this, that in the observance of the Holy Supper the Lord comes to the body also, and takes possession of it.

Not only does He work by His Spirit on our spirit, so as to make our body share in redemption at the resurrection. No, already, here, the body is the temple of the Spirit, and the Sanctification of soul and spirit will progress the more gloriously, just in proportion as the undivided personality, including the body, which exercises such an opposing influence, has a share in it.

All that has now been said about the Supper, must have its full application to "The drinking of the Blood of Jesus." It is a deep spiritual mystery in which the most intimate, the most perfect union with Christ, is effected. It takes place where the soul, through the Holy Spirit fully appropriates the communion of the Blood of Christ and becomes a true partaker of the very disposition which He revealed in the shedding of His Blood.

The Blood is the soul, the life of the body; where the believer as One Body with Christ desires to abide perfectly in Him, there, through the Spirit, in a superhuman powerful way, the Blood will support and strengthen the Heavenly life. The life that was poured out – the Blood – becomes His life.

The life of the old "I" dies to make room for the life of Christ in him. By perceiving how this drinking is the highest participation in the Heavenly life of the Lord, faith has one of its highest and most glorious offices.

It remains to inquire:

III. WHAT SHOULD BE OUR ATTITUDE TOWARDS THIS DRINKING?

ONLY HE WHO LONGS FOR FULL UNION WITH JESUS WILL LEARN ARIGHT WHAT IT IS TO DRINK THE BLOOD OF JESUS.

"He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood dwells continually in Me, and I [in like manner dwell continually] in him."

- He who is satisfied with just the forgiveness of his sins;
- he who does not thirst to be made to drink abundantly of the love of Jesus;
- he who does not desire to experience redemption for soul and body, in its full power, so as to have truly in himself the same disposition that was in Jesus:

will have but a small share in this "drinking of the Blood."

He who, on the other hand, sets before him as his chief object, that which is also the object of Jesus: "abide in Me and I in you" who desires that the power of eternal life should operate in his body; he will not suffer himself to be frightened by an impression that these words are too high or too mysterious.

He longs to become Heavenly minded because he belongs to Heaven, and is going there; therefore he desires to obtain his meat and drink also from Heaven. Without thirst, there is no drinking. The longing after Jesus and perfect fellowship with Him is the thirst which is the best preparation for being made to drink the Blood.

IT IS BY THE HOLY SPIRIT THAT THE THIRSTY SOUL WILL BE MADE TO DRINK OF THE HEAVENLY REFRESHMENT OF THIS LIFE-GIVING DRINK.

We have already said that this drinking is a Heavenly mystery. In Heaven, where God the Judge of all is, and where Jesus the Mediator of the New Covenant is, there also is "the Blood of sprinkling" (Heb. Xii. 23,24).

Heb. 12:23-24 "23 And to the church (assembly) of the Firstborn who are registered [as citizens] in heaven, and to the God Who is Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous (the redeemed in heaven) who have been made perfect, 24 And to Jesus, the Mediator (Go-between, Agent) of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood which speaks [of mercy], a better and nobler and more gracious message than the blood of Abel [which cried out for vengeance]."

When the Holy Spirit teaches us-taking us, as it were, by the hand-He bestows more than our merely human understanding can grasp.

All the thoughts that we can entertain about the Blood or the life of Jesus about our share in that Blood, as members of His Body; and about the impartation to us of the living power of that Blood; all are but feeble rays of the glorious reality which He – the Holy Spirit – will bring into being in us through our union with Jesus.

Where, I pray, in our human bodies, do we find that the Blood is actually received, and as it were drunk in? Is it not where one member of the body after another, through the veins, receives the blood-stream which is continually renewed from the heart? Each member of a healthy body ceaselessly and abundantly drinks in the blood.

So the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus, who unites us to Him, will make this drinking of the Blood the natural action of the inner life.

When the Jews complained that what the Lord had spoken concerning eating His flesh and drinking His Blood was "a hard saying," He said "It is the Spirit Who gives life [He is the Life-giver]; the flesh conveys no benefit whatever [there is no profit in it]."

It is the Holy Spirit who makes this divine mystery LIFE AND POWER in us a true living experience, in which we abide in Jesus and He in us.

THERE MUST BE ON OUR PART A QUIET, STRONG, SETTLED EXPECTANCY OF FAITH, THAT THIS BLESSING WILL BE BESTOWED ON US.

We must believe that all the precious Blood can do, or bestow, is really for us. Let us believe that the Saviour Himself will cause us, through the Holy Spirit, to drink His Blood unto life. Let us believe, and very heartily and continuously appropriate those effects of the Blood which we understand better, namely, its Reconciling, Cleansing, Sanctifying effects.

We may then with the greatest certainty and joy, say to the Lord: "O Lord. Your Blood is my life drink. You have washed and cleansed me by that Blood, You wilt teach me every day "to eat the flesh of the Son of man, and to drink His Blood" so that I may abide in You and You in me."

He will surely do this.

I. STATEMENTS ABOUT THE BLOOD OF JESUS:

- 1. The Blood of Jesus has redeemed me from the hand of Satan.

 1(R)*
- 2. The Blood of Jesus has redeemed me from all curse.²
- 3. The Blood of Jesus has stamped an eternal covenant for me?³

{Because of this covenant and if I fully obey the Lord my God and carefully follow all His commands and walk in His ways, the Lord my God will set me high above all the nations on earth and all the blessings of the covenant will come upon me and accompany me. I will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country; I will be blessed at my work and the fruits of my labour will be blessed. I will be blessed when I come in and blessed when I go out.

The Lord will grant that the enemies who rise up against me to be defeated before me; they will come at me from one direction but flee from me in seven. The Lord will send a blessing on my barns and on everything I put my hand to and the Lord my God will bless me in the land He is giving me. The Lord will establish me as His holy people, then all the peoples on earth will see that I am called by the Name of the Lord and they will fear me and the Lord will grant me abundant prosperity.

The Lord will open for me the heavens, the storehouse of His bounty, to send rain on my land in season and to bless all the work of my hands so that I will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. The Lord will make me the head, not the tail and I will always be at the top, never at the bottom.⁴}

- 4. The Blood of Jesus has granted me peace and reconciliation with all creation; with all my brethren, (The members of the Body of Christ), with ministers and pastors of the church and with all people.⁵
- 5. The Blood of Jesus has granted me the forgiveness of all my sins.⁶
- 6. The Blood of Jesus, the Son of God, purifies me from all sin.⁷

- The Blood of Jesus justifies me from all blame, so all the devil's charges against me are nullified and He makes me righteous as if I have never sinned.⁸
- The Blood of Jesus sanctifies me and consecrates me so I become belonging to my Lord, dedicated to Him and set apart for His ministry.⁹
- 9. The Blood of Jesus cleanses my conscience from acts that lead to death so that I may serve the Living God.¹⁰
- 10. The Blood of Jesus makes me enter the Most Holy Place to serve God the Holy. 11
- 11. The Blood of Jesus makes me overcome Satan and all his power. 12
- 12. The Blood of Jesus is the cause of my eternal joy. 13

II. THE COVERING OF THE BLOOD AND PROPHESYING OVER THE DIFFERENT MEMBERS OF MY BODY

1. MY HEART

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my heart: (R)

It will not be a corrupt¹⁴ heart or a hard heart of stone¹⁵, but a compassionate new heart of flesh. ¹⁶

It will not be a hardened uncircumcised heart¹⁷, but a tender circumcised heart¹⁸ (a heart that strikes me whenever I sin). ¹⁹ It will not be a rebellious stubborn²⁰ heart or a dead heart²¹, but a submissive willing²² heart (an eagerly obedient heart). It will not be a heart bound up with folly²³ or misleadings²⁴ but a heart hourself.

It will not be a heart bound up with folly²³ or misleadings²⁴, but a heart of wisdom.²⁵

★ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my heart: (R)

It will not be a faint heart that disheartens other hearts²⁶, but a steadfast and secure heart.²⁷ It will not be a sinful unbelieving heart²⁸, but a sincere heart in full assurance of faith.²⁹

It will not be an unclean heart with a guilty conscience³⁰ or anxious thoughts, but a purified clean heart.³¹

It will not be a divided heart³², but a fully committed whole heart.³³

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my heart: (R)

It will not be a proud heart³⁴, but a humble and meek heart.³⁵ It will not be a puffed up heart³⁶, but a broken and contrite heart.³⁷ It will not be a shaken heart as trees are shaken by the wind³⁸, but a quietened peaceful heart.³⁹ It will not be a perverse heart⁴⁰, but an integral heart.⁴¹

Conclusion:

The Lord will give me a new heart and will put a new spirit in me. 42 (R)

The Lord will put His laws in my mind and write them on the tablets of my heart. ⁴³ (R)

2. BONES AND JOINTS

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my bones and joints :(R)

My bones shall receive the power of resurrection⁴⁴ and my joints shall receive the anointing of love.⁴⁵

So my bones shall live⁴⁶; my bones shall be healed and nourished ⁴⁷; my bones shall be strengthened⁴⁸; my bones shall rejoice⁴⁹ and my bones shall be healthy.⁵⁰

My bones shall be joined and held together by joints and ligaments⁵¹; tendons and flesh shall be put on them and skin shall cover them⁵²; breath shall enter them⁵³ and the city of my self⁵⁴ (E.F.) shall be built up.

3. MYSELF

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on the city of my self: (R)

Its walls shall fall, its bars of iron shall be cut and its gates shall be broken to pieces.⁵⁵

Its altars shall be destroyed, the carved images of its gods shall be cut down, its sacred pillars and wooden images shall be broken. ⁵⁶ The name of the enemy shall be destroyed from every place in it ⁵⁷ and his high places shall be removed. ⁵⁸

Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth.⁵⁹

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on the city of my self: (R)

The altar of God shall be built, the walls shall be built and the doors hung. ⁶⁰

The ruined and desolate places shall be built and the desert shall blossom. ⁶¹

And Christ shall be formed in me. 62 (R)

And the city of my self, Jerusalem, shall be the city of the great King.⁶³

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my inner Jerusalem: (R)

It shall put on her strength, her beautiful garments; a holy city, the uncircumcised and the unclean shall no longer come to it.⁶⁴ But it shall be a dwelling place of God in the spirit⁶⁵, a home for the Trinity⁶⁶, a place for the Holy one and my heart a throne for the high.

4. MY HEAD

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my head: (R)

All the devil's plans on my life shall be as nothing and shall perish. ⁶⁸ There is no sorcery or divination against me. ⁶⁹

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my head: (R)

The hair of dedication and the locks of the Nazarites shall start to grow for me; the locks of love and power. ⁷⁰

So my head becomes like Mount Carmel and the hair of my head like royal tapestry ⁷¹; a crown flourishes on my head ⁷² and everlasting joy shall crown my head. ⁷³

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my head: (R)

I shall be given the covers for the head: the turban and the helmet. ⁷⁴ Then my head shall be exalted above the enemies who surround me⁷⁵ and my horn shall be exalted with glory⁷⁶

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my face: (R)

Every downcast expression in my face⁷⁷, every darkness in my face⁷⁸, and every feature of the evil one in it⁷⁹, shall disappear.⁸⁰ I shall be given a face like the face of my early fathers⁸¹; lifted up with honour, shining with grace, decent with gentleness and a living stone of witness.⁸²

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my face: (R)

I offered my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting.

Therefore have I set my face like flint and I know I will not be put to shame. 84

♦ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my face: (R)

My forehead is like adamant stone before my enemies⁸⁵ and the seal of the redeemed protects me.⁸⁶

My temples behind my veil are like the halves of a pomegranate.87

6. MY MIND

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mind and on my conscious and unconscious thoughts: (R)

All arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God shall be demolished: and every thought shall be brought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.⁸⁸

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mind and on my conscious and unconscious thoughts: (R)

All thoughts of doubt and lack of love⁸⁹, lack of humility and peace⁹⁰; all thoughts of timidity and frustration⁹¹, all thoughts of hatred and malice⁹², arrogance and pride⁹³, cowardly and fearful thoughts⁹⁴, all shall be exposed and abolished.

And I shall be given thoughts of faith and love, the thoughts of humility and peace.⁹⁵

And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard my heart and my mind in Christ Jesus. ⁹⁶

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mind and on my conscious and unconscious thoughts: (R)

All deceitful thoughts⁹⁷, all dark and negative thoughts, all unruly thoughts⁹⁸, all shall be exposed and abolished.

Whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, and whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - I think about such things.⁹⁹

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mind and on my conscious and unconscious thoughts: (R)

All earthly and human wisdom¹⁰⁰ shall be exposed and abolished; its economy shall be abolished, its power shall be dispersed and its darkness shall be cast away.

And the Lord my God shall light my darkness¹⁰¹ so that I receive the wisdom that comes from heaven.¹⁰²

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere.¹⁰³

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mind and on my conscious and unconscious thoughts: (R)

All visualizations and imaginations shall be abolished and all memories shall be healed. 104

My mind shall be renewed¹⁰⁵ and its eyes shall be enlightened.¹⁰⁶ So it is opened to understand the Scriptures¹⁰⁷ and I shall have the Mind of Christ and the Light of the Spirit.¹⁰⁸

7. MY EYES

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my eyes: (R)

Every bad eye shall be taken away and I shall be given good eyes¹⁰⁹, non haughty eyes,¹¹⁰ straight eyes that look straight ahead¹¹¹, eyes that see many things but does not pay attention,¹¹² eyes that cover others and does not judge anyone,¹¹³ self controlled eyes that does not desire anything.¹¹⁴ My eyes will then be like doves behind a veil.¹¹⁵ My eyes will be opened to the needy. I will not keep to myself, but give generously.

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my eves: (R)

The scales and all that blurs the eyes shall fall¹¹⁶ and every plank shall be uncovered and shall be burnt.¹¹⁷
So my eyes shall be opened¹¹⁸ and enlightened¹¹⁹ and your commandments shall be as frontlets between my eyes.¹²⁰

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my eyes: (R)

I shall be given the manifold lamps of the Spirit¹²¹ and my eyes shall be like blazing fire.¹²¹ I shall be given fountains of tears¹²³ and my eyes shall be like the pools of Heshbon.¹²⁴

And I shall wet the feet that have freed me from the path of going astray¹²⁵; I shall weep for the slain of the daughter of my people.¹²⁶ And I shall overflow with tears because the Lord's flock has been taken captive.¹²⁷

So my eyes will find favour; my eyes have captured the Lord's attention. 128

8. MY EARS

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my ears: (R)

All deceitful voices¹²⁹, every deafness that hinders the hearing of God's voice¹³⁰, and all then other plans of the evil one, all shall be exposed and abolished.

My ears shall be circumcised and opened¹³¹ to hear morning by morning, to hear like one being taught.¹³²

So I shall discern the voice of the Shepherd from the voice of the stranger¹³³ and I shall receive teachings from the Lord.¹³⁴ And I shall have fellowship with angels and saints.¹³⁵ So I shall hear a word behind me saying: 'This is the way, walk in it', whenever I turn to the right hand or whenever I turn to the left. ¹³⁶ The earrings of the Spirit shall protect my ears.¹³⁷

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my ears: (R)

My ears, you have opened: I give attention to your words; I incline my ear to your sayings. I delight to do Your will, O my God. ¹³⁹ My ears, you have opened; I obey the voice of my teachers, I incline my ear to my instructors. ¹⁴⁰ I delight to do your will, O my God.

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my ears: (R)

The sovereign Lord has opened my ears, and I have not been rebellious; I have not drawn back. 141

Pierce my ear with an awl so I become a servant for life and serve you forever. 142

9. MY NOSE

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my nose: (R)

Every pride, every compelling and forcing and every plan of the evil one bearing in it the odour of corruption, shall be exposed and abolished. ¹⁴³

My nose shall be like the tower of Lebanon looking towards Damascus. ¹⁴⁴ No enemy will subject me to tribute; no wicked man will oppress me. ¹⁴⁵

The fragrance of my breath like apples¹⁴⁶, the fragrance of my beloved that casts away the odour of corruption and I shall discern the order of corruption and I shall run away from it and I shall get drawn and attracted to the aroma of holiness and long for its source. Pleasing is the fragrance of Your perfumes; no wonder the maidens love You! ¹⁴⁷

The ring of the Spirit¹⁴⁸ complete my submission to the Lord and His will and to those in higher authority than me in Christ.¹⁴⁹

10. MY TONGUE, TEETH AND THROAT

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mouth, tongue, teeth and throat: (R)

Every bitterness and poison, every anger and wrath, every cheating and deceit, every coarse jesting and all which is not fitting¹⁵⁰, every idle word¹⁵¹, shall be taken away from my mouth and my mouth shall be purified from all that is bitter. ¹⁵² I shall be given a muzzle for my mouth and the bridle of the Spirit for my tongue¹⁵³ so that no corrupt word shall proceed out of my mouth but what is good for necessary edification that it may impart grace to the hearers. ¹⁵⁴ My speech shall always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that I may know how I ought to answer each one. ¹⁴⁵ And I shall always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks me a reason for the hope that is in me with meekness and fear. ¹⁴⁶

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mouth, tongue, teeth and throat: (R)

My lips are like a strand of scarlet. ¹⁵⁷ My tongue is the pen of a ready writer ¹⁵⁸ that proclaims the glory of God, praises His name and talks of His righteousness all day long. ¹⁵⁹

My tongue is like the tongue of the instructed who sustains the weary with a word. My tongue is a polished arrow inside a quiver. My teeth are like a flock of sheep which have come up from the washing, everyone bears twins and none is barren among them. My voice shall be powerful and full of majesty.

My mouth shall be a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth that threshes the mountains and crushes them and reduces the hills like chaff. 164

11. MY MOUTH

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my mouth and words: (R)

I shall be given words like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces and like life coal and arrows of fire 165 for awakening and releasing. I shall be given enlightening revelatory words that cast away darkness.

I shall be given fervent¹⁶⁷ reviving words that cast away coldness and death. I shall be given words with manifold anointing¹⁶⁸ to fulfill God's purposes.

❖ The power of the blood of Jesus on my mouth and words: (R) I shall be given comforting and encouraging words that support

and strengthen.

I shall be given words like milk and honey¹⁷⁰ that satisfy and bring joy. I shall be given words of discernment and distinction¹⁷¹ to reveal and discern.

I shall be given words of truth¹⁷² so that the precious shall be taken out from the vile from my mouth¹⁷³.

So, my mouth shall be as the mouth of the Lord¹⁷⁴, none of its words shall fall to the ground.

Put a muzzle to my mouth as long as the wicked are in my presence. 176

Set a guard over my mouth. O Lord; keep watch over the door of my lips¹⁷⁷.

My words that I have put in your mouth will not depart from your mouth, or from the mouths of your children, or from the mouths of their descendents from this time on and forever, says the Lord. ¹⁷⁸ He shall give me words whenever I open my mouth so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the Gospel ¹⁷⁹.

12. MY NECK

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my neck: (R)

The bondages shall be broken and the yokes shall be destroyed My neck will not be a stiff neck but an abiding neck slain with the knife of obedience. 181

So that I may receive the anointing of the Spirit one after the other and I may have the anointing oil. 182

Every yoke shall be destroyed and the yoke of Jesus shall be laid upon my neck for His yoke is easy and His burden is light. 183

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my neck: (R)

Its decoration and armour, the necklaces of the Spirit and the shields of faith, shall be completed.

So that my neck will be like a tower of ivory, decorated by the necklaces of the Spirit and the bonds of love. 184

My neck is like the tower of David built for an armoury on which hang shields of mighty men. 185

13. MY SHOULDERS

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my shoulders: (R)

The yoke that burdens me, the bar across my shoulders, and the rod of my oppressors you have shattered. ¹⁸⁶

You have removed the burden from my shoulders. 187

Heal me from the effects of the loads and pains. 188

So it will no more be a shrugged isolated shoulder 189, but a helpful shoulder with one accord. So we can carry the ark of the Lord together.

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my shoulders: (R)

Their ornaments and their armour, onyx stones and the badges of the government, shall be completed.¹⁹¹

To raise up the tribes of the Lord (like Moses) and fight the fights of the Lord (like David).

14. MY ARMS AND HANDS

❖ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my arms, my forearms and my hands: (R)

Bonds shall be absolved, laziness shall cease¹⁹², and every sin shall be purified. I wash my hands in innocence¹⁹³ and tie your words as symbols on my hands.¹⁹⁴

★ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my arms, my forearms and my hands: (R)

The arm of the Lord shall strengthen me¹⁹⁵, the arm of the Lord leads me¹⁹⁶ and His arm rules for me.¹⁹⁷

The arms of my hands were made strong by the hands of the Mighty God of Jacob. 198 My hands shall not go limp, but the feeble hands shall be strengthened. 199 I have put my hands to the plow I shall not look back. 200

Their ornaments and armour shall be completed, the rings and the bracelets.²⁰¹

So my hands shall be full with blessing and help and shall be accompanied with authority.²⁰² The work of my hands shall be established²⁰³ and the will of the Lord shall prosper in my hands.²⁰³

15. JOINTS AND LIGAMENTS

★ The power of the Blood of Jesus on my joints and ligaments²⁰⁵ in this part so it will receive the anointing of love related to this part: (R) [the purpose is: communicating love to others]

Love is not rude 206 , Love is not proud 207 , Love keeps no record of wrong 208 , Love does no envy 209 , Love is not self seeking. 210

16. CHEST, FEELINGS AND EMOTIONS

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my chest, feelings and emotions: (R)

Passions and bondages shall be absolved, selfish ambitions shall be abolished, fears and disturbances shall be cast away, wounds shall be healed and needs shall be satisfied; all feelings and emotions shall be sanctified.²¹¹ I shall not be withholding my affection but rather open wide my heart. ²¹² I shall not be cruel but tender with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.²¹³ I shall not be selfish and self-centered, but rather sacrificial, looking not only to my own interests but also to the interests of others.²¹⁴ My breasts shall be like clusters²¹⁵ and towers.²¹⁶

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my chest, feelings and emotions: (R)

I shall be filled with the divine love, a pure, strong and steadfast love, a sacrificial love that bears pain and a bridal love. ²¹⁷ Set me like a seal upon your heart, like a seal upon your arm; for love is as strong as death, jealousy as cruel as the grave, its flames are flames of fire, a most vehement flame. Many waters cannot quench love nor can the floods drown it. ²¹⁸

The power of the Blood of Jesus on my chest, feelings and emotions: (R)

I shall be filled with the love of the brethren and shall love fervently with a pure heart²¹⁹ I shall love not in word or in tongue but in deed and in truth.²²⁰

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren because whoever sees his brother in need and shuts his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him.²²¹
