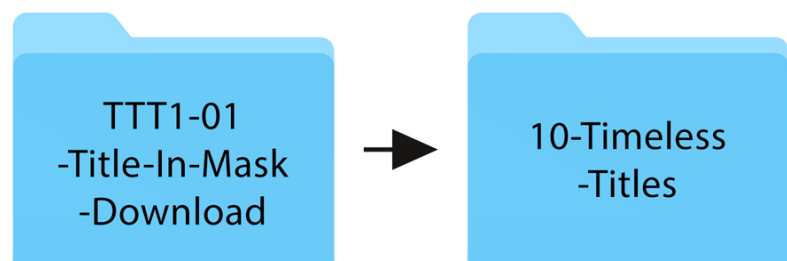
NOTE: Complete Lesson 1 before continuing with the challenges.

Homework: Make a Master Folder

This class will have 10 individual lesson folders, but no master folder to hold it all. My recommendation is to

- Create a master folder on your computer.

- Save it in an easy-to-find location, like your Desktop, while you're taking this class.
- Place your TTT1-01-Title-In-Mask-Download folder from Lesson 1 inside the new folder.



Challenge #1: Create a New Design

The Title PSDs you create in this class are designed to be versatile. So, test out the process.

- Create a page design completely different from the layered quick page you were given.
- Add the Title PSD layers to your new page.
- Change the mask to one from your stash. For an extra challenge, use more than one mask.
- Change the font. See how creative you can get.

Challenge #2: Create & Send a Card

- Create a 6x4 card design using the Title PSD layers.
- Change the mask to one from your stash. In my card, I also added a heart to the Title In Mask group.
- Change the font. See how creative you can get.
