Quick Tips for Choosing a Font

- Change the titles to match the mood or subject of your page. Script fonts work well for love and romance. To make a bold statement, use a bold font. If you have a grungy page, use a grungy font.
- Change journaling to match the mood or subject of your page. Handwriting fonts personalize the page. Fonts with all caps can make a design statement. If you want your page to have a reflective, heritage feel, use a soft script font.

How To Change the Font in a Template

- In the Layers panel, click on a type layer you want to change to activate it.
- Get the Horizontal Type tool.
- In the Tool Options, choose a different font.

NOTE: Not all fonts are created equal. After changing the font, you might also need to adjust the Size, Leading, and Tracking.
