- o Black acrylic paint
- Assortment of brushes
- Mod Podge ("Make Your Own" recipe below)
 - Assortment of old magazines
 - Scissors
- O Cup of water, paper towel, & painting pallet
 - Drop cloth (optional)
 - Empty yogurt container
 - o Canvas board to use as collage backing

A WORD ABOUT MATERIALS:

CANVAS BOARD

Stretched canvas, a piece of wood, or cardboard could work as well. Painting paper or thick drawing paper could also work (make sure to tape down your paper until your artwork is dry to avoid the paper curling!)

DROP CLOTHS

Painters tarps, an old bed sheet, extra plastic, whatever is at your disposal!

OLD MAGAZINES

Travel, animal, and photography magazines work very well as they tend to be filled with colorful images with lots of interesting textures!
