BRUSHES

DRAWING

- · Mechanical pencil with B lead
- Kneaded rubber eraser

PAPER

 Cut sheets of Fabriano CP 140 lb Bright White Watercolour Paper, 9" x 11" (You can also use a good quality watercolour sketchbook)

WATERCOLOUR PALETTE

 Any folding watercolour palette with spaces for pigment and a large mixing area is fine. I use an Alvin Heritage Palette.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- · Paper towels for cleanup
- Two water containers
- Bulldog clips or masking tape
- Small spray bottle for rewetting dry paints in palette
