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What is AquaBoost?

- Non-invasive hydrodermabrasion facial equipment that provides exceptional exfoliation, extractions, and hydration.
- Remarkably **smooth, radiant skin** in just 3 steps!
- Safe form of epidermis exfoliation, sebum reduction, blemish extractions, and product penetration
- Custom treatments with easily adjusted levels of solution flow and suction



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What Makes AquaBoost Unique?

Patented Treatment Tip

The patented treatment tip is non-abrasive and has a unique dome shape that glides along the skin. It performs the physical exfoliation your guests know and love but without the irritation. AquaBoost's treatment tip is safe for all skin types and skin conditions, even the most sensitive skin. What's more, you're not required to change treatment tips during an AquaBoost service.



Cryotherapy with Blue LEDs

Not found on other hydrodermabrasion systems, the CryoWand is unique to the AquaBoost machine. This round, handheld wand completes your AquaBoost service by providing multiple benefits, is safe for other areas of the body, and can be incorporated into other services.

Cryotherapy

- Minimizes any redness by encouraging vascular movement back through the skin.
- Helps to close the pores and promote firm, glowing skin

Blue LED Lights

- Helps to destroy bacteria remaining on the skin from extractions
- Cools and comforts the skin post AquaBoost service



Serums

You know your guests' skin better than anyone. So, we created a safe, highly efficacious serum system that allows you to select which serums are best. Containing beneficial natural source ingredients, these serums provide hydration, exfoliation, and antioxidants to nourish skin while keeping its integrity top of mind. You'll select Serum 1, Serum 2, or both to help you meet your guests' skin care goals.



No Downtime

Pairing our patented treatment tip with our custom serums, AquaBoost provides a safe, effective service without downtime. The gentle nature of the treatment tip allows for more frequent services. And our carefully selected ingredients produce results without stripping the skin, meaning there's less chance of irritation or reaction.

AquaBoost services can be received without concern of skin shedding or peeling, and without the level of redness seen in other types of dermabrasion services. Guests can return to their day without disruption.



Benefits of AquaBoost

AquaBoost can be performed as a stand-alone treatment or as an upgrade.

However you choose to incorporate AquaBoost, guests will experience multiple benefits.

Reduces the appearance of fine lines & wrinkles	Skin shows signs of aging as the body's natural processes begin to slow. Skin also appears to be "aging" when we lose a healthy glow. By removing dead skin cells on the epidermis and infusing skin with hydrating ingredients, it looks vibrant, healthy, and youthful.
Exfoliates for smooth, radiant skin	AquaBoost delivers superior physical and chemical exfoliation. Its serums are introduced to the skin to gently loosen the cellular bond of dead skin cells. The treatment tip then provides gentle, effective friction to physically remove dead skin cells, resulting in luminosity.
Removes impurities	AquaBoost combines custom formulated treatment serums with user adjustable vacuum pressure to gently extract impurities from the skin.
No downtime or discomfort	Natural source ingredients and gentle humectants provide effective treatments with less risk of skin sensitivity. Exfoliation is achieved with a combination of physical and chemical forms and doesn't cause the skin to shed for days or weeks following a treatment. Instead, dead skin cells are gently removed and swept off the skin immediately, leaving only healthy, glowing skin tissue.
Deeply hydrates skin	AquaBoost infuses ingredients like hyaluronic acid, aloe, lactic acid, and ceramide NP. Serum is delivered to the skin with a pressurized, user adjustable treatment wand. This allows the products to penetrate the skin at a deeper level than pressing with hands alone can provide.
Minimizes post-treatment redness with cryotherapy	The CryoWand provides a cooling touch to the skin which comforts the skin post treatment and promotes healthy blood flow being pushed back through the skin. This can result in less redness post treatment.

AquaBoost Contraindications

While AquaBoost is a safe and effective treatment, if you question a guest's ability to have an AquaBoost facial, it is recommended you follow your company policy to determine if performing a treatment is appropriate.

Pregnant or Nursing

It is recommended that guests check with their doctor before receiving any type of treatment.

Medication

Guests currently taking Accutane, or other topical/oral medications that can cause fragile and/or thinning skin, should not receive the AquaBoost treatment until cleared by their doctor.

Open Skin Lesions

Areas of the skin that have open lesions should be avoided as to not cause tearing or additional skin trauma (e.g., acne, rosacea, etc.).

Sensitive Skin

Active rosacea may not be suitable for AquaBoost treatments.

Sensitized skin that reddens easily can receive treatment. It's important to adjust your settings as needed for your guest comfort and results.

Clients may ask you questions about the AquaBoost treatment, so we created some FAQs for you.

What is AquaBoost?	A hydro dermabrasion system that effectively cleanses, exfoliates, and infuses hydration for glowing skin!
Can I have an AquaBoost service if I have sensitive skin?	Yes! AquaBoost is safe for all skin types.
How Does AquaBoost help with acne?	AquaBoost removes the dead skin cells that trap dirt and oil while its cleansing serums dissolve impurities and promote radiance. Your skin can then return to its natural function, softer and looking healthier and clearer.
My skin gets red easily! Will I be able to return to work after my service?	Absolutely! AquaBoost is effective yet gentle so there's no downtime. And every AquaBoost service concludes with our unique CryoWand which cools and calms the skin. This encourages continued vascular activity, resulting in less redness.
How long is the service?	AquaBoost takes just 15 minutes! It's a perfect service upgrade OR stand-alone service. It's quick and can even happen on your lunch break.
If I have active rosacea, can I receive an AquaBoost Service?	It is recommended that you wait until the flare-up subsides.
l just received a peel 2 weeks ago. Can I receive an AquaBoost service?	It is recommended that you wait at least 4 weeks after a peel before receiving an AquaBoost service.
Are there any instructions I need to follow after my AquaBoost service?	 Refrain from any retinol or home use acids, such as salicylic or glycolic, for the remainder of the day of service. Apply sunscreen daily. Enjoy your glowing skin!

Looking for additional ways to incorporate AquaBoost into all your treatments? AquaBoost allows you to customize your service experience by layering in one, or all, of the AquaBoost Elements. The chart below shows some examples of common skin conditions and concerns and what AquaBoost elements help to address those concerns.

These are general recommendations. AquaBoost treatments are intended to be customizable based on client's specific needs.

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Using Your AquaBoost

Serum Flow & Suction

- Begin your treatment with settings turned completely down to 0.
- Ensure that serum is flowing from the treatment wand prior to gliding on the skin. Do not, at any point, test your treatment wand on your skin. Using a gloved hand, turn the suction down low, and press the treatment wand on your glove to ensure serum is flowing.
- Adjust your suction and serum flow throughout the service based on guest need. Be sure to check in with your quest to gauge their comfort level.
- If you notice your guest's skin is very "thirsty," increase your serum flow.
- If you notice the treatment wand "skipping" or releasing rapidly and unexpectedly, turn your suction down and be sure you're holding the skin taut.
- If your guest is experiencing dripping of serum, turn your serum flow down and your pressure up.
- Keeping your guests skin type in mind, having pressure at 2.5 and flow at 3:00 position is a good starting point.








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Using Your AquaBoost Treatment Wand Usage



Always hold the skin taut

with one hand and glide your treatment wand with the other hand. This will help to prevent skipping or rapid release of the treatment wand.

Work in sections

and adjust your settings for more stubborn extractions.

When working on the nose:

Always support the opposite side of the nose when applying pressure.

Remember to pop the crease of the nasal labial fold to thoroughly cleanse and extract.



NOTES

Using Your AquaBoost

CryoWand + Blue LED Lights

- Turn on the CryoWand and allow about a minute for the wand to cool.
- Apply a thick gel or serum to the skin. Using a cream mask is **not recommended**.
- · Begin at the chin.
- Apply to the skin and move in upward, circular motions.
- Move the wand in the same pattern as your treatment wand, from the inside to the outside of the face.
- You can spend extra time on areas that required more intense exfoliation or extractions to provide additional comfort for the skin.
- The CryoWand can be used on the full face or on a specific area (extraction site, for example).
 However you choose to incorporate the CryoWand, it is important that you remember to:
 - Keep the wand moving in circular motions and do not allow the wand to sit in one place on the skin.
 - Use a gel or serum to provide slip on the skin.



Note: Depending on your product selection, you may notice some product dry out and find the CryoWand does not glide easily and therefore causes tugging on the skin. In this case, additional product or slip may be required. Applying product to the full face immediately following Serum 3 is highly recommended. At that moment, skin is prepped and ready to receive additional nourishment. Therefore, applying product all at once is recommended.

CLEANSE	Prosana Refining Cleanser	 Cleanse the skin using 1-2 pumps of the Prosana Refining Cleanser Once the skin has been cleansed thoroughly, remove the cleanser with a hot towel
TONE	Prosana Refining Mist OR Hydrating Mist	Refining Mist: • For skin in need of added exfoliation or dull, lackluster skin. Apply with a cotton round or esthetic wipe avoiding the eye area. Hydration Mist • For thirsty skin in need of added hydration. With eyes covered, spray directly over the face or use a cotton round or esthetic wipe to apply.
SERUM 1	Prosana Cleanse + Exfoliate	Turn on your AquaBoost equipment. Using the AquaBoost Serum 1, cleanse and exfoliate the skin. *Please refer to the Owners Manual for usage instructions.

MASK	Select Prosana Sheet Mask of your Choice	Apply a Prosana mask that best suits your guests needs and leave on for 8 minutes. Recommended masks include: Hyaluronic Acid Sheet Mask 4-in-1 Full Face Crystal Collagen Gel Mask Vitamin C Crystal Collagen Gel Mask
HAND MASSAGE	Prosana Nail & Cuticle Oil	While your client is masking, perform a hand and nail massage.
REMOVE MASK		Gently remove the sheet mask.
CRYO WAND	Apply additional serum from within the Prosana Mask pouch .	 Feel the skin to determine if enough product remains on the skin to provide a slip for the Cryo Wand. If the skin is tacky, apply remaining serum from the mask package to the skin with hands for facial brush. SERUM 1 or SERUM 2	Cleanse & Exfoliate or Deep Cleanse	 Perform 1 pass with Serum 1 or 2: Beginning at the chin, move in upward and outward motions. Hold the skin taut with one hand while gliding with the other to ensure a smooth glide without skipping or rapid release. Follow the grid provided in the Training Manual for added guidance. Spend additional time as needed in areas of increased congestion. *Approximately 3 fl. oz of serum will be used.
SERUM 3	Soothe & Hydrate	Perform 1 pass with Serum 3: • Press excess serum into the skin throughout the service. *Approximately 2-3 fl. oz will be used.
CRYOWAND	Select Gel Mask or Heavy Gel Serum	Perform 1 pass with CryoWand Begin at the chin, move in circular motions upward and outward. Keep the CryoWand moving at all times.

STEPS	PRODUCT NAME	INSTRUCTIONS
Cleanse	Select Cleanser of Your Choice	Thoroughly cleanse the back to prepare the skin for the AquaBoost treatment.
Extoliate	Serum 1 Cleanse & Exfoliate	Work from the inside to the outside of the back. (ie from the spine to the side) Hold the skin taut with one hand while gliding the treatment wand with the other. This will help avoid skipping and rapid release of the wand. Work in sections from inside to outside completing: Mid Back Upper Back & Shoulders **The full back can receive the AquaBoost service, however will require additional serum than accounted for in the protocol. It is also feasible to spot-treat specific
