## U (oo)

### How it's spelled:

oo: mood, food, loose, tool, choose, too, cool, boots, noon, moon, proof

u: rude, attitude, super, rule, truth, tune, lunatic, ukelele, sushi, dude

ew: screw, few, pew, view, new, dew, brew

ou: you, youth, soup, wound (hurt)

ue: true, blue, queue, due, value

### Less common spellings:

o: lose, who, movie

eau: beauty, beautiful

ui: juice, fruit, suit

oe: shoes

### Sentences:

I choose to eat super foods to lose weight.

The mood of the movie changed Ruth's attitude.

Lucy's new computer is a beauty.

Susan spilled fruit juice on my suit around noon.
