## What you will need for the Papermaking session

Rusty pan or Aluminum disposable pan, 12 x 10 x 3, again see what you have to use already.

Spray bottle with 1/2 water and 1/2 vinegar

1 garbage plastic bag that will fit over the pan you use

Hibiscus tea or if you can find Blueberry that works too.

Coffee filters-[Amazon](#)

Copper Flashing-[Home Depot](#)

Roll of Coffee filter paper-[Amazon](#)

Material like [flour sacks](#) or white sheets can be used also. Best that it's white material for the truest color from the rust and teas resonate nicely.

Regular Marbles work, but if you want to try the Wooden Marbles-[Amazon](#)

Black India Ink-Black Cat - [Blick Art Materials](#)

Aluminum pan

Drawing paper cut to size of pan

Paper plate for ink palette

**You can use** other inks of different colors. I just stuck with black ink for the high contrast and color can be added in as you collage and use the mixed media, though I highly nudge you to experiment with color too.

I always encourage my students to explore and experiment, these are basic processes that can be expanded on in many ways.

Depending on you supplies and what you have already I have two version of creating Rusty papers. I suggest watching the videos first to see what you will need and have laying around the house.
