<h?> Headings <h?> (<h1>, <h2>, <h3>, <h4>, <h5>, <h6>)

<p> Paragraph </p>

<i> Italic </i> or Emphasis

 Bold or Strong

 Anchor/Link Opens link to another web pages in new tab/window.

 Unordered List Bullet-point list

 Ordered List Numbered list

<div id="first" class="section"> Division </div> Divides up page content for styling

 Image.

<hr> Horizontal Rule, a simple separator

 Span , inline container, mark up only a part of a text

 Line break, a single line break/new line
