Hello! I'm Profe\$\$or Dollar and welcome to my Academy. This course is a series of ten short lessons designed to teach your children about being responsible with money. I'll talk about what money is, saving it, spending it and managing it. My goal is to encourage saving and responsible spending.

The accompanying workbook has blanks for the student to fill in and a few surveys and exercises. I've targeted this course for those between Kindergarten and Third Grade, although other age groups may find it useful.

As a basis for learning to be responsible with money, I recommend an allowance that equals two times the student's age. This may seem like a lot of money for a young child, but it comes with the responsibility of paying for their own expenses, saving, planning for the future and giving. This gives them an opportunity to begin making an elementary budget and allows them to make buying mistakes without too many repercussions.

I encourage you to watch the lessons with your children and add your expertise and experiences to the information. Younger students may need help with some of the workbook activities, but I encourage letting them figure it out by themselves before jumping in to help.
