OBJECTIVE

The objective of this lesson is for the kids to memorize these basic colors in Spanish. As you read the phrases at the bottom of the lesson plan, you will notice that the colors change to either an 'a' ending or 'o' ending. This is because of the gender of the noun. I will explain this in the group but don't get too hung up on this for now. Just have them memorize the colors.
