JUnit on BlueJ and Eclipse

JUnit is an **API**, so it will work for both **BlueJ** and **Eclipse**. There is not much difference because the Unit Testing framework is independent of **IDEs**. It will work for **BlueJ**, **Eclipse** and **NetBeans**.

BlueJ is a light-weight IDE, no find/replace, not much plug-ins, not cross-language, simple package/module management. The functionality is limited but it is easy to use. Just little bit bigger than **Notepad**. All of the files it created can be copied into Eclipse environment very easily.

Eclipse is the de facto industrial standard for Java IDE. Co-development is these two IDE brings some advantages. (Compilation for BlueJ is faster but not enough for big projects.)
