

## GLOSSARY OF SAP S/4HANA VIM (VENDOR INVOICE MANAGEMENT)

A Quick Reference Guide to SAP Terminologies



| Concept/Term                           | Definition  |
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| SAP VIM (Vendor Invoice<br>Management) | A solution for automating and streamlining the process of managing vendor invoices, from receipt to payment, integrated into SAP S/4HANA.     |
| Invoice Processing                     | The process of receiving, validating, and posting vendor invoices in SAP S/4HANA, ensuring accuracy and compliance.                           |
| OCR (Optical Character<br>Recognition) | Technology used in SAP VIM to automatically read and extract data from scanned vendor invoices, reducing manual data entry.                   |
| Three-Way Matching                     | A process in SAP VIM where the vendor invoice is matched against the purchase order and goods receipt to verify accuracy before payment.      |
| Invoice Receipt                        | The stage where vendor invoices are received and entered into the SAP system for processing, often using scanning or electronic transmission. |



| Concept/Term         | Definition  |

| Invoice Verification | The process of checking and validating the vendor invoice against purchase orders and goods receipts for correctness before posting in SAP.         |
| Invoice Posting      | The final step in SAP VIM where the invoice is posted to the accounts payable ledger, creating a financial document in the system.                  |
| Supplier Portal      | A web-based interface for suppliers to submit invoices, track payment status, and communicate with the purchasing and accounts payable teams.       |
| Approval Workflow    | A system that defines the steps and approvals required before an invoice can be processed or paid in SAP VIM, often involving multiple departments. |
| Invoice Receipt Date | The date on which the vendor invoice is received, which is used to determine payment due dates and help manage cash flow.                           |

| Payment Terms              | The agreed-upon terms between the buyer and supplier regarding when and how payment for invoices will be made, often influencing invoice processing in SAP VIM. |
| Accounts Payable           | A financial account in SAP used to manage money owed to vendors, including the recording and payment of vendor invoices.  |
| Goods Receipt (GR)         | The process of confirming the physical receipt of goods, which is used to match against the vendor invoice and purchase order in SAP VIM.                       |
| Purchase Order (PO)        | A document issued by the buyer to the supplier outlining the terms, quantities, and prices of goods or services, used in the matching process in SAP VIM.       |
| Invoice Exception Handling | A process in SAP VIM for managing invoices that cannot be processed due to discrepancies, such as missing/incorrect information, requiring manual intervention. |





| Concept/Term       | Definition   |
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| Payment Proposal   | A list of invoices prepared for payment in SAP S/4HANA, typically generated based on due dates and payment terms, ready for approval.                                      |
| Credit Note        | A document issued by the supplier to reduce the amount owed on an invoice, often handled through SAP VIM for adjustments in the accounts payable process.                  |
| Debit Memo         | A document issued by the buyer to adjust an overpayment or incorrect invoice, also managed in SAP VIM to correct vendor accounts.  |
| Document Splitting | A feature in SAP that allows the separation of financial transactions into different accounts based on predefined criteria, often used in VIM for more detailed reporting. |
| Tax Calculation    | The process of determining the correct amount of tax to be applied to an invoice, which is handled in SAP VIM based on regional tax rules and invoice details.             |



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| Invoice Archiving         | The process of storing vendor invoices electronically within SAP for future reference and compliance, reducing physical storage needs.            |
| Workflow Approval Process | A predefined series of actions that require approvals from specified users before an invoice can be processed or paid in SAP VIM.                 |
| Invoice Coding            | The process of assigning appropriate general ledger codes to vendor invoices in SAP VIM, ensuring proper accounting and reporting.                |
| Payment Run               | A process in SAP that automatically generates payments for approved invoices, based on payment terms and available funds.                         |
| Invoice Reconciliation    | The process of ensuring that the invoiced amounts match the amounts due in SAP, verifying that payments have been correctly applied and balanced. |

| Document Flow          | A feature in SAP that tracks the movement and status of invoices, including approvals, postings, and payments, providing a complete audit trail.      |
| PO Invoice Matching    | The matching of vendor invoices to purchase orders and goods receipts in SAP, ensuring that only valid invoices are processed for payment.            |
| Payment Block          | A temporary hold on an invoice in SAP VIM, often used when discrepancies or issues are identified, preventing payment until resolved.                 |
| Early Payment Discount | A discount offered by suppliers for early settlement of invoices, typically calculated and managed within SAP VIM for optimizing cash flow.           |
| Partial Payment        | A payment made for part of an invoice amount, which may occur when full payment is not due or when negotiated with the supplier, recorded in SAP VIM. |



| Concept/Term                       | Definition  |

| Invoice Header                     | The top section of an invoice containing summary information such as invoice number, date, and vendor details, processed in SAP VIM for initial validation. |
| Invoice Item                       | The detailed line items of a vendor invoice, such as product description, quantity, price, and total amount, validated and posted in SAP VIM.               |
| Batch Input                        | A method of entering multiple invoices into SAP VIM at once, typically for bulk invoice processing, improving efficiency.                                   |
| Goods Receipt Invoice Verification | A process in SAP VIM where the system verifies the match between goods receipts and the vendor invoice before posting the invoice.                          |
| Invoice Amount                     | The total monetary value of the vendor invoice, including items, taxes, and any adjustments, which must be validated and posted in SAP VIM.                 |



| Concept/Term               | Definition  |
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| Invoice Approval Hierarchy | A defined structure of who must approve the invoice at various stages before it can be posted or paid, ensuring compliance and oversight.         |
| Exception Workflow         | A special workflow process in SAP VIM for handling invoices that do not conform to standard rules, requiring additional steps or review.          |
| Duplicate Invoice Check    | A process in SAP VIM to ensure that the same invoice is not processed and paid multiple times, reducing the risk of overpayment.                  |
| Invoice Data Extraction    | The process of automatically extracting invoice data, such as amounts, dates, and item details, often using OCR or electronic formats in SAP VIM. |
| Vendor Master Data         | The record in SAP that contains key information about a supplier, such as name, payment terms, and contact details, used for invoice processing.  |





| Concept/Term                   | Definition   |
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| Invoice Validation             | The process of verifying that an invoice meets all the required criteria, such as matching PO, GR, and correct payment terms, before posting in SAP VIM. |
| Early Payment Processing       | The handling of invoices for early payment opportunities, optimizing cash discounts and supplier relationships in SAP VIM.                               |
| Payment Terms Adjustment       | The process of modifying the payment terms on an invoice based on supplier negotiations or other business needs, processed in SAP VIM.                   |
| Vendor Invoice Approval        | The workflow or process in SAP VIM that requires approval from designated personnel before an invoice is posted to accounts payable.                     |
| Invoice Discrepancy Resolution | The process of resolving discrepancies between vendor invoices and purchase orders or goods receipts, handled within SAP VIM before payment.             |

| Invoice Status           | The current state of an invoice in SAP VIM, indicating whether it is pending, approved, paid, or blocked due to issues.                 |
| Invoice Posting Date     | The date when the invoice is posted in SAP S/4HANA, which impacts financial reporting and payment due dates in SAP VIM.                 |
| Vendor Credit Management | A process in SAP VIM that ensures that vendors' credit terms and limits are respected during invoice processing and payment.            |
| Invoice Dispute          | The process of handling customer or vendor disputes related to invoices, often involving manual intervention or corrections in SAP VIM. |
| Payment Reconciliation   | The process of matching paid invoices with payment records to ensure that all payments are accurately tracked and posted in SAP VIM.    |
