Yesterday I-am managed to-swim five kilometers.

NOTE: Serbian: Juče sam uspeo da preplivam pet kilometara.




Misliti na što

To mean

Do you get what I mean?

Razumješ li na što mislim?

You-understand? on what I-think?



To mean (signify)

Značiti

I don't know what this word means.

Ne znam što ova riječ znači.

Not I-know what this word means.





Should (suggestion)

Treba

Maybe you should talk to your daughter again.

Možda trebaš ponovo razgovarati sa svojom kćeri.

Maybe you-have again to-talk with your-own daughter.

NOTE: Serbian: Možda treba da porazgovaraš sa svojom ćerkom ponovo.





To come on foot

Dolaziti

She used to come to me every morning.

Ona je dolazila kod mene svakog jutra.

She is come at me every morning.



To come on foot (perfective)

Doći

He has just arrived.

On je upravo došao.

He is just arrived.



To arrive, to come by vehicle

Doći

Come to see us for the weekend.

Dođi kod nas u goste za vikend.

Come at us at guest for weekend.



To arrive, to come by vehicle (perfective)

Stići

What time did you arrive yesterday?

U koliko si stigao jučer?

In how-many you-are arrived yesterday?



Place

___ Mjesto

What about another place?

Što misliš da odemo na drugo mjesto?

What you-think that we-go to other place?





Somewhere

___ Negdje

It seems to me that I've seen you somewhere before.

Čini mi se da sam te vidio negdje ranije.

It-seems to-me self, that I-am you seen somewhere before.





Nowhere

___ Nigdje

Nowhere is safe.

Nigdje nije sigurno.

Nowhere not-is safe.



To show

Pokazivati

Why are you showing me this?

Zašto mi to pokazuješ?

Why to-me it you-show?



To show (perfective)

Pokazati

What did you want to show me?

Što si mi htio pokazati?

What you-are to-me wanted to-show?

NOTE: Serbian: Šta si hteo da mi pokažeš?



Too

Također

Men cry too.

Muškarci također plaču.

Men also cry.



To explain

Objašnjavati

You don't have to explain anything.

Ne moraš mi ništa objašnjavati.

Not you-have to-me nothing to-explain.

NOTE: Serbian: Ne moraš ništa da mi objašnjavaš.



To explain (perfective)

Objasniti

I need a lawyer to explain this contract to me.

Treba mi odvjetnik da mi objasni ovaj ugovor.

It-is-necessary to-me lawyer that to-me explain this contract.



In the morning

Ujutro

I usually don't eat anything in the morning.

Ujutro obično ništa ne jedem.

In-the-morning, usually nothing not I-eat.





In the afternoon


Popodne

I always take a nap in the afternoon.

Popodne uvijek ležim i drijemam.

In-the-afternoon always I-lie-down I-take-nap.





In the evening

Uvečer

In the evening I like to watch TV.

Uvečer volim gledati televiziju.

Yesterday I-love to-watch television.

NOTE: Serbian: Uveče volim da gledam televiziju.
