

## **RECOMMENDED SUPPLY LIST**

5.5" x 8.5," 7" x 7" or 7" x 10" **Watercolor** Sketchbook (<https://amzn.to/3cc44tz>). For someone just getting started I recommend Canson Montval Watercolor Spiral Bound Pad, 5.5" x 8.5". Regardless of the brand, please be sure your sketchbook plays well with watercolors!

#2 Pencil or mechanical pencil

White Eraser

Kneaded Eraser

Gray Permanent Pen in 3.0 or a Black Permanent Pen in 3.0 or F tip – Please see **Pen Recommendations** below.

Uni-Ball® White Signo\*\* Gel pen in white(<https://amzn.to/3fOl8Ea>)

#7 or #8 round brush (<https://amzn.to/39fMgu5>) **OR** a large waterbrush

Watercolors

Carbazole Violet\*\* (<https://amzn.to/2Y0ZU01>) **OR** Dioxazine Purple\*\*(<https://amzn.to/3tKfgUa>) **OR** Winsor Violet – These are all the same pigment, just different names depending on the brand you buy.

Facial Tissues

Paper Towels

Ruler

Watercolor Pencils in a variety of colors **OR** markers (they can be waterproof or non-waterproof)

### **Optional Supplies**

White Sharpie® Poster Paint Pen in a Fine Tip

White titanium watercolor paint (<https://amzn.to/2Q3EvSB>)

**\*Pen Recommendations:** For the Gray Permanent Pen – Derwent Graphik LineMaker (<https://amzn.to/3j6xJWA>). For the Permanent Black Pen – Faber Castell® Pitt® Pens (<https://amzn.to/3vQ1llj>) **OR** Pigma® Micron® (<https://amzn.to/3lAkry>). The Uni-Pen Fine Line Pen Set (<https://amzn.to/3lASTJ>) has both light and dark grays as well as a sepia and a black. Be very careful of using Sharpie® permanent (non-paint) markers as they can bleed through your paper months after you use them.

**\*\*Be sure to have the supplies marked with a double asterisk as it is key to the success of the project.**

### **Supplies I'll Be Using**

I used both carbazole violet (<https://amzn.to/2Y0ZU01>) and white titanium watercolor (<https://amzn.to/2Q3EvSB>) paint to create my project. Carbazole violet and dioxazine purple are the same pigment, a strongly staining violet, which goes by different names depending on the brand. No other violet will work as they are not staining.

I also used just about **every color in my paint box** to complete my project! Make sure to have a good green like Sap Green (<https://amzn.to/3ovFk3f>) to complete this project. I used a Derwent Graphik LineMaker (<https://amzn.to/3j6xJWA>) in Graphite gray for all of the ink work.

I also used watercolor pencils to complete the lettering. Markers, colored pencils or paint could also be used for this step.
