
MEET YOUR PIANO

Did you know? Piano is the easiest instrument to make a nice sound on. Let's do it!

Using the black notes as your guide, find the notes C and F on your piano.

Black notes on pianos come in groups of 2 and 3. C is the note to the left of the 2 black notes and F is the note left of the 3 black notes.





More Fun Things To Try:

Be a kid again, explore sounds! Do you have a favorite note? Mine is G. No idea why, it just is :-)

- Find all of the C's up and down the piano. Any finger will do! How many are there?
- Find all the **F's**. Are there the same number of F's and C's?
- With your left hand play 3 E's
- With your right hand play 3 A's
- Make up something else to find :-). Use that as your note of the day and everytime you walk by your piano, play it.

...old joke! The vertical lines are called **barlines**. They divide music into sections which help us keep track of where we are. The music between two bar lines is called **one bar** (no drinks though!)
