




LET'S COLOUR A GIRAFFE!

- Okapi are the closest relative of giraffe.
- New research has found there are not 1, but 4 species:
 - Northern, Southern, Masai and Reticulated.



RARE IN THE WILD



- Many giraffe populations in the wild are under threat.
- Their numbers have plummeted by 40% in the last 30 years.
- There are only less than 100,000 giraffe remaining in Africa.
