

Let's Make Candy Cane Bark Lesson

Learning Objectives:

Students will learn how to make candy cane bark and make it.

Materials & Preparation:

- Let's Make Candy Cane Bark power point (included)
- Let's Make Candy Cane Bark sequencing activity (multiple levels included)
- Let's Make Candy Cane Bark writing picture prompt (included)
- Let's Make Candy Cane Bark matching activity (included)
- Scissors & glue (you provide)
- Candy Cane Bark ingredients (you provide)

Instruction:

- Who likes sweet treats? How about with a minty taste? Has anyone ever used candy canes in their treats?
- Let's Make Candy Cane Bark power point

Full Class Activity:

- Make candy cane bark!! Display the power point if needed to move to the next step for the cooking lesson. Have each student read a slide as you go.

Independent Working Time:

- Matching activity
- Writing picture prompt
- Sequencing activity, remind students to remember what they did when they were making the candy cane bark.

Wrap up/Closing:

- Review what they made and how. Remind them how important cooking is for their independence and that you will continue working on meals and snacks they can prepare for themselves!

Other Ideas for Activities:

- Take pictures of the students doing each step and make a book of themselves making the candy cane bark (or whatever recipe you're working on). Students can also write the story to go with their book and

take it home for parents to see. It's so much more meaningful when they see pictures of themselves doing/participating in activities.

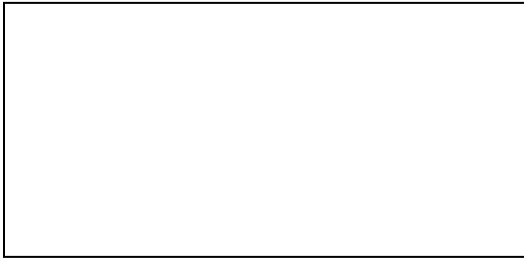
Draw a line to sequence the steps for making candy cane bark.

| Step 9 | Put into refrigerator to harden |

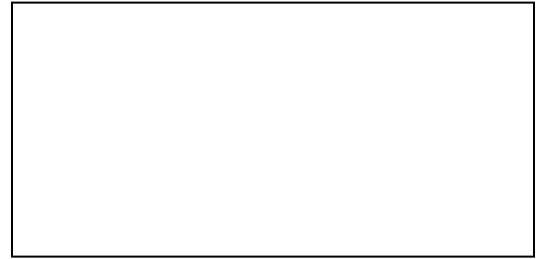
