
Lesson Structure:


- 1. The melody

- 3. Playthrough with the backing track


The Melody:

- This melody is slightly more challenging than the others because it doesn't stop we're sweeping the entire time.
- **SWEEPING TIP:** whenever you have more than once note per string, you only pick once.
- Whenever you go back a string, switch picking direction.

- 2. Write your own sweep melody for the backing track. The chords are Dm, Bb, C7 and A7 and the last chord of each section is Dm. Challenge yourself when you write this melody.
