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THE PLAN OF SALVATION

–as revealed in the Mo’edim–

If you know the flow of the Biblical Feasts you will understand what I’m about to share. If you don’t walk in Yah’s Feast Day Rhythm (which BTW is a HUGE part of obedience) – – then you are blind and are walking around in the dark. And you are probably completely confused about how salvation happens. Well, perhaps you just plain don’t care. But for those who do care and if you want peace about this – – then listen up! I have good news for you!

Many people just enjoy my videos and teachings because I’m help them learn

to DO Yah's Feasts. They may think of me only as a "decorator, cook and hostess" for something that is cool or optional to do. But this is not so. I'm after so much more than that. I don't decorate, cook and host His Feasts for my health, as a hobby or to make money. His Feast Rhythm consumes me (as it should you) because in it we find not only Yah's Lesson Plan for the year, but the Plan of Salvation. This Holy-day Rhythm shows AND helps us prepare for the Happily-Ever-After. And I don't know about you, but I want that more than anything else in the World.

So today, I'm going to show you how Yah's Plan to deliver us is revealed through His Mo'edim. I will start with Chanukah and end with Shemini Atzeret. You will see why in a moment.

Okay, Salvation goes like this, starting with Chanukah:

CHANUKAH (the Feast of Dedication)

Cleaned, Re-Dedicated & Filled with Oil

During **CHANUKAH** you discover that people are a house for a god and that you get to choose which god inhabits the temple of your heart and body.

At this Feast of Dedication you discover that the temple of you is filthy and that other gods have been inhabiting your house! The Ruach ha'Kodesh isn't there

because She, like the dove that Noah sent out from the Ark, isn't attracted to death and floating carcasses like a raven is. She only lands on things that are alive, clean and inviting.

But thankfully, you find out that YHVH wants to cleanse your heart from idolatry so that She can land in your heart; so that you, as part of His living temple can become re-dedicated back to your original purpose and be all He created a human to be.

The process of becoming a dwelling place for Elohim all starts by recognizing that your heart and the dress (garment) you're wearing has been stained with idolatry. It starts by recognizing that a stained dress will get you thrown out of the future Great Wedding Feast of the Lamb.

Not easy. This cleansing starts with choosing this fight just like the Maccabees in the story of Hanukkah chose to fight. It won't be easy, but know that YHVH is with you to give you success like He gave Judah Maccabee.

So, at Chanukah you begin a process of getting your heart, body and 'garment of actions' scrubbed up and healed so that the Ruach ha'Kodesh can live in you and so you can produce good fruit and be saved.

Get the Ruach. Remember that you MUST have the Ruach ha'Kodesh. She is the oil that your wick needs in order for Ye'shua, who is the Light of the World to produce a flame in you. With Her work, which starts at Chanukah you will eventually become a bright and lit up house on a hill helping others around you to see.

PURIM

The Enemy, 2 Decrees, The Dress and Adornments

Then, during the next Festival of **PURIM** you discover that there is an enemy who hates you and lives to put your light out. This Enemy has forged a legal DEATH decree to annihilate you, but you also discover that YHVH has forged a counter decree of LIFE which allows you to fight for your life.

You start this battle by fasting and praying like Queen Esther did—acknowledging your sins, the sins of Israel and then you pray that YHVH will turn the schemes of those who want to kill you back upon themselves and that they will be destroyed instead of you. You get up from your knees and make a Feast fit for the King (aka: the Mo'edim).

Our motivation. But what will you wear to the Feast that will please the King and will help Him want to grant you your life? Just like Esther inquired of Hegai (who knew the King) you surrender your will to the Ruach ha'Kodesh (who knows The King). You inquire of Her as to what you should wear. She knows that ONLY the clean dress of 'Right Doings' (aka: the 'Robe of Righteousness') will get you chosen so that you can attend the future Wedding Feast of the Lamb. If you don't have that dress (garment) on, the scepter will not be extended to you and you will be banished from the King forever.

The Ruach ha'Kodesh will help you get dressed properly, BUT a plain dress actually isn't enough to woo the heart of the King. No. YHVH wants to reveal His glory and splendor through you, the Bride. The King wants your dress to sparkle. Like Hegai, YHVH's Ruach ha'Kodesh helps you adorn your dress with beautiful things that will please Him. These adornments on your dress

reveal His character to the nations and show how much He loves you!

And remember, that as you prepare the Feast and seek to get the dress that will please Him—you give your life over to YHVH to deliver you—or not. If you perish you perish, but perhaps you are here for such a time as this. Yes, you do all this with the Death decree still hanging over your head and the end result still unknown.

So how do we get this very important dress (garment)?

Let's find out as we proceed through the Feasts.

ROSH HA'SHANAH (Head of the Year)

Appointments and Original Design

On the next Festival, **ROSH HA'SHANAH** you discover when (by which reckoning of time) you are to show up to get your filthy dress (garment) cleaned and adorned so that it pleases the King. At Rosh ha'Shanah you find out when you should throw the Feast for Him—while you await for the verdict on your life (like Queen Esther did).

Also, on the Head of the Year we remember the King's Creation before it was destroyed with idolatry. We remember His Original Design of what He meant when He created humans to bear the image (masculine) and likeness (feminine) of Elohim and what the 'dress of righteousness' looked like before the Fall. Let's continue moving forward through the Feasts to discover YHVH's Plan of Salvation...

THE LAST SUPPER

New Contract

On this evening, as Believers in the Messiah we partake of the cup and bread that He broke, blessed and told us to “do in remembrance of me.” This was the covenant confirming meal of the New Covenant (Contract) to keeping the Royal Law of Love. He has knocked on the door of our hearts to get us here to this point. By taking part in the wine and bread this night you are accepting His proposal of marriage as the Kinsman Redeemer for YHVH. Betrothal and then Marriage is not in the bag yet as you have to prove out your commitment and stay in this promise you are making by taking the cup and bread. But the preparations are being laid for the Big Day. He said He would not partake of this cup again until He sees us again. Perhaps, like in the Hebrew wedding ceremony after the cup between the two betrothed had been shared it would be broken—symbolic of not sharing this cup of marriage with anyone else (He’s good for His word).

PESACH (Passover)

Born Again, Cleaned White as Snow

At the next Feast of **PESACH** you get your dirty dress and heart of stone washed in the Lamb’s blood. At this Feast you become born again through blood and through the womb of the Mother, the Ruach ha’Kodesh. Through this re-birth you become circumcised to YHVH and now have a heart of flesh. The Son’s life-giving blood begins to flow through your new heart. His blood

washes away any stains you had on your dress and makes it white as snow. His blood on the doorposts of your heart signal to the destroyer to pass over you giving you a chance to chose life. Ye'shua's blood, which annointed the Ark of the Covenant on Pesach makes a path by which you can walk to keep this white dress that is required to attend the future Great Wedding Feast of the Lamb.

CHAG HA'MATZOT (Unleavened Bread)

Learn to Eat and Become like Ye'shua

At the very next Appointment of **UNLEAVENED BREAD** you are now dressed properly to sit at the Royal Table where you will consume a life-saving meal the King has prepared for you. You have your new heart and your snow white garment on. Without these things you can't eat from this table. During this 7-day Feast you will eat of His Son, the Unleavened One—the Bread of Life which will make you perfect (complete) before the King. The Father has already confirmed that His Son, Ye'shua is perfect and fully pleases Him, Therefore at the Feast of ULB as you eat of Ye'shua, the Ruach ha'Kodesh shows you the sparkles that Ye'shua, the Bread of Life owns and that He wants to share with you. By consuming Ye'shua you will become like Him and the sparkles (fruits) that please the King will just begin to appear on your snow white dress.

Do you see how the preceding Feasts of Chanukah, Purim and Pesach have prepared you to eat this very important meal of Unleavened Bread? It's impossible to eat this Holy Meal with idols in your stoney heart or with a "filthy dress" on.

Remember: if you don't have the right wedding garment on Ye'shua said that you'll be kicked out to where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth and you won't get to eat of the life-saving meal that has been prepared for you. OMG this dress is important!

THE RESURRECTION

The Guarantee

The very next thing that happens in the Feast line-up is the **RESURRECTION**. It is the Resurrection that makes the future Wedding Feast of the Lamb a sure thing. Without the Resurrection this Story would have ended right here. There would be no future Wedding Feast to wear your dress to. There would be no "Happily-Ever-After." But it doesn't end here! Praise YHVH! Because of the Resurrection the Wedding Feast of the Lamb is now a sure thing.

Whether you are there or not, is still to be seen.

There are some more Feasts to go through.

YOM HA'BIKKURIM (First Fruits)

The Real Hope for Enduring

During the next Feast, the Feast of **FIRST FRUITS** you are reminded WHY you got dressed properly and WHY you are eating this Holy Meal of Unleavened Bread that Yehovah prepared for you. First Fruits reveals what awaits you.

First Fruits is the hope you need that shows you the end result and reward of the action of consuming Ye'shua; wearing His white and clean wedding garment of 'Right Doings' to His table; and gaining His already pre-approved sparkles (fruits).

This Feast reminds us that the First Fruits of the Earth are now living in realized hope . . . and our turn will soon follow. The Hope of First Fruits helps you to keep your dress clean; it helps you keep eating of Ye'shua, the Bread of Life; it helps you polish up your sparkles (fruits) and helps you endure until the end.

THE ASCENSION

Given Power to Resist

As you continue to eat and drink of Ye'shua, the Bread of Life, you grow in ever-increasing holiness to be perfect like Him (or complete). In this process you begin to acquire many precious jewels and gems that make your dress sparkle and glow (aka: fruits). But now your dress is extremely valuable. And the enemy (the thief) REALLY wants to steal it and thus destroy you—preventing you from attending the Great Wedding Feast of the Lamb. But through the **ASCENSION** you now have access to Ye'shua's power and HIS authority. He shares it with you. He sits you beside Him in the Heavens and wants you to wield His power to destroy the thief who is after your dress.

Wielding Ye'shua's power that He received from the Father at His Ascension will keep your dress white and clean; it will preserve your beautiful sparkles; it will keep your heart from turning back into a heart of stone; it will keep you alive so that you can show up to the next Feast.

SHAVUOT (Feast of Weeks)

Betrothal, Mikvah, Priesthood duties

At **SHAVUOT** you will take your vows and enter into a betrothal arrangement with the King through a legal Contract. This is important because Salvation is actually a legal transaction between you and YHVH. But you can only enter Shavuot and this contract with the white wedding dress on that the Ruach ha'Kodesh has helped you acquire through the preceding Feasts and Festivals.

Remember that you can not wear just any old dress for the formality of Shavuot, because Shavuot is a time for the formal betrothal agreement under the chuppah. It is a time of vow making in Yah's Name. This is a serious moment. Your dress is your destiny. And your destiny hangs on making this Shavuot agreement with the Creator.

Inspection. At Shavuot the Father of the Bridegroom “inspects” your heart and your dress. Hopefully, during His inspection He discovers that you are going to be a perfect eternal Bride for His Son. Hopefully, He finds that you have listened to the Ruach ha'Kodesh whom He sent to help you acquire the white dress. Hopefully, He finds out that you have allowed Her to adorn your dress with His sparkles. Hopefully, He discovers that you love His Son and that you are already proving that out by doing what His Son said to do.

Mikvah into the family and assume Priesthood duties. On Shavuot you mikvah into The Family Name. You stand under the chuppah of Shavuot to receive your new identity in The Family of YHVH which has been made possible through the work of Ye'shua and the Ruach ha'Kodesh. If your dress

pleases the Father then on Shavuot you will be chosen to take a vow and enter your legal status as “Betrothed” to His Son. After which, you will begin preparing to meet your Bridegroom in the flesh in the future – all while He is preparing a place for you in His Father’s house. Until then, on Shavuot you begin your Royal Priesthood duties under your High Priest, Ye’shua who was made Cohen Godal over YHVH’s Eternal Priesthood Order of Melchizedek. You will fulfill these Priesthood duties as you wait for the title “Bride.” Guarding your Bridegroom’s Father’s Shabbats is what you will do to wear the sign of your betrothal.

YOM TERUAH (Feast of Trumpets)

Deliverance.

It is on the next Feast of **YOM TERUAH** when the Father releases His Son to claim His Kingship over the Earth. The first thing the Son does is come get His Bride who has been keeping her dress white, clean and sparkling; her lamp burning with the indwelling of the oil of the Ruach ha’Kodesh; and who has been enduring and patiently waiting for Him to come for her. At this point, all the preparations are completed and you, as part of the Bride, will have instant access to meet your Bridegroom at His second coming.

The hope of First Fruits will become your reality on this day. Immortality will be yours instantly as you have been pre-qualified to enter this moment through the continued wearing of your white wedding dress and covenant fidelity to the Melchizedek Royal Law of Love that you entered into on Shavuot.

YOM KIPPUR (Day of Atonement)

Legalities and Wedding Feast of the Lamb!

Because you were claimed by Ye'shua on Yom Teruah you can be assured that your new heart, your white dress of Righteousness and your sparkles are good enough to protect you as you proceed through the Judgment day of **YOM KIPPUR**. Brother Judah who believed at the coming and has thus endured the 10 days of wrath to prove out their faith will be joined up with you on the sea of fire and glass to sing their song to YHVH. Israel is now all one Bride and of one heart.

On this sober Feast the Court in Heaven is opened and your name will hopefully be found in the Book of Life. You will be found innocent because you have believed YHVH and have walked the Narrow Path of Salvation at all costs! You will get a white acquittal stone and be legally made part of YHVH's Family, heir to the inheritance through a marriage-type arrangement with YHVH's Son and the Kinsman Redeemer, Ye'shua ha'Mashiach. This legal alliance will force ha'Satan to release his claim on you, forever.

Yom Kippur climaxes in your dress becoming your ticket to attending the Great Wedding Feast of the Lamb that evening. Without having that dress on you don't get in.

SUKKOT (Feast of Tabernacles)

Living and Reigning Together

Second Adam (Ye'shua) and Second Chavah (The Bride, Israel) complete the Original Prime Directive. Five glorious days later, during the joyous Feast of **SUKKOT** you will return to Earth with your Bridegroom who is also the Rightful King of Planet Earth and you will begin to reign beside Him as His Bride (aka: Queen).

The second Adam, Ye'shua, your Bridegroom will bind that snake and jail him for judgement. And then you, the "Bride" and Ye'shua, the "Husband" will fulfill the original prime directive that Yah gave to Adam and Chavah. The one that they failed to do. For 1,000 years the King and His Queen will rule the Earth together extending the Garden and removing from it the snake, and its offspring.

The Pair will put all the enemies who were full of darkness and set against life under His feet (aka: destroy them). You will never be parted again from your true Family in Heaven: the Son (Ye'shua), the Father (YHVH) and the Mother (the Ruach ha'Kodesh). You will forever be immortal, healthy, a perfect image or likeness bearer of Elohim and you will enjoy the Happily-Ever-After and being and doing all that you were created to be and do.

SHEMINI ATZERET (Last Great Day)

Naked and Unashamed, Paradise Restored

Removing the dress. Finally, at the start of the 8th Millennium as seen in the Feast of **SHEMINI ATZERET** you will take off the dress and will be seen for who you really are, completely transformed to the core to be just like Ye'shua, the Son of YHVH. The dress now has become part of your very being. Naked (aka: with no hidden agendas) and completely unashamed in your transparency – you are a perfect image or likeness bearer of the Family in Heaven. And just like humanity was before the Fall Yah will say again, “it is good.”

Cleansing the Earth and YHVH arrives. Shemini Atzeret sets His Bride apart from the nations. You will watch as on the drama and climax of Shemini Atzeret happens at the beginning of the 8th Millennium. This Story ends when Papa YHVH raises the wicked, judges them and doles out their reward of eternal separation from Him – – and you. You will watch on as He cleanses the Earth with fire and starts over to bring to life His Original Creation.

On that final Shemini Atzeret He will come to live in the flesh and face-to-face with you and His NEW Creation. Paradise itself will be restored. The New Jerusalem and the Father will arrive and the Family will live together – forever. All death, disease, tears, sickness, darkness, evil, distress, the curses and everything that has ever caused pain and hardship will be wiped away.

From there on out it will be the Happily-Ever-After, for real!

This is the Plan of Salvation. **It's all about the dress.**
