

## Supplies you need for this course:

Check out our <u>Amazon list</u> to get supplies to your house fast. Or just check it out to see what to look for at the store (hello, fan brush!). Note that budget or last-minute options are listed in parentheses.

## **Art/Office supplies:**

- 3 sheets white printer paper (to print downloadable PDFs)
- 2 sheets watercolor paper (or card stock)
- Pencil
- 12" ruler
- Scissors
- Coloring supplies (use whatever you have on hand: colored markers, colored pencils, crayons, etc.)
- Oil pastels (or colored crayons)
- 1 small tube of black acrylic paint
- · Watercolor paints (tube or hard-pressed Crayola)
- Small paintbrush
- · Medium-large, or fan-style paint brush
- White crayon
- Hot glue gun (optional)
- · Elmer's liquid glue
- 2 yards of yarn or twine (any color)

## Around the house/yard:

- Printer
- Household implements for with a sharp tip (chopstick, fork, dull pencil, comb, toothpick, etc. try different things!)
- Cardboard (8"x10" recommended, but you can use any size you want even try using the brown inside of a cereal box! Just cut the tabs off and use one panel)
- Colorful mementos from a nature walk (twigs, leaves, bits of wrappers, etc.)
- Dish soap (any regular brand will do)
- Mixing cup (or disposable container)
- Paint water cup (use a drinking glass or disposable container)
- Wax paper (or baking parchment paper)
