NON-PROFIT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (NPSG)

- The NSGP provides funding support for target hardening and other physical security enhancements and activities to non-profit organizations that are at high-risk of terrorist attack.



NPSG PROCESS

- Contact State Administrative Agency (SSA)
- Obtain UEI (Unique Entity Identifier) Number
- **Prepare Sub-Application Materials**
- Submit Sub- Application Materials



VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT (VA)

- Conduct and/or Review the VA
- Identify:
 - Threats **(T)**
 - Vulnerabilities **(V)**
 - Consequences **(C)**

(Terrorist Attacks)



SECURITY ASSESSMENT

- An evaluation of your facility's physical protection system. An assessment is conducted by a security professional who is trained and certified to conduct the work.



ASSET IDENTIFICATION (C)

- Define assets
- Asset classifications
- Critical assets

Consequence Rating:

- Events
- Consequence/Impact Level



THREAT ASSESSMENT (T)

- Define threat
 - The likelihood of an attack being attempted by an adversary
- Elements
- Threat classifications

Threat: Terrorist Attack:

- Gather information for multiple sources



VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT (V)

- Define vulnerability
 - The likelihood that an attack will be successful
- Review
 - Operations
 - Equipment
 - Processes
- Classifications
 - Observable
 - Exploitable



INVESTMENT JUSTIFICATION

- Linked to threats, vulnerabilities and consequences
