Collect Your Photos

When you find your photos in one of these locations, move them to a designated folder or hard drive that will be backed up. A backup is an additional copy of the files, just in case anything happens to the originals. One secure and easy option is to <u>back up online</u>. The software will automatically upload new photos as you save them onto your computer. For the most secure backup, also consider making a second local copy of the files on an external hard drive.
