## More ideas:

How about fun challenges instead of telling fortunes: Name five things you can see, Name one thing you can hear, describe yourself with three words, describe me with three words, say three things you are good at, tell a joke, do a ninja pose for 10 seconds, pat your head and rub your tummy, etc.

Turn your fortune teller into a fruit joke teller. Draw a fruit on each corner instead of a colour and use some fruit jokes, like: What do you give to a lemon that's been hurt? Lemon-aid! What kind of fruit can fix your sink? A Plum-er! Look online for more ideas.

Another idea is to turn it into a fact-teller about your favourite sport (most points scored, tallest football player, best winger) or famous landmarks (tallest building, longest bridge, etc.)

Ask a question out loud that can be answered with a 'yes' or 'no'. Place a pencil in the middle of the wheel, spin it and find out what the answer is!
Examples: Can I have an ice-Cream? Will it rain today?
