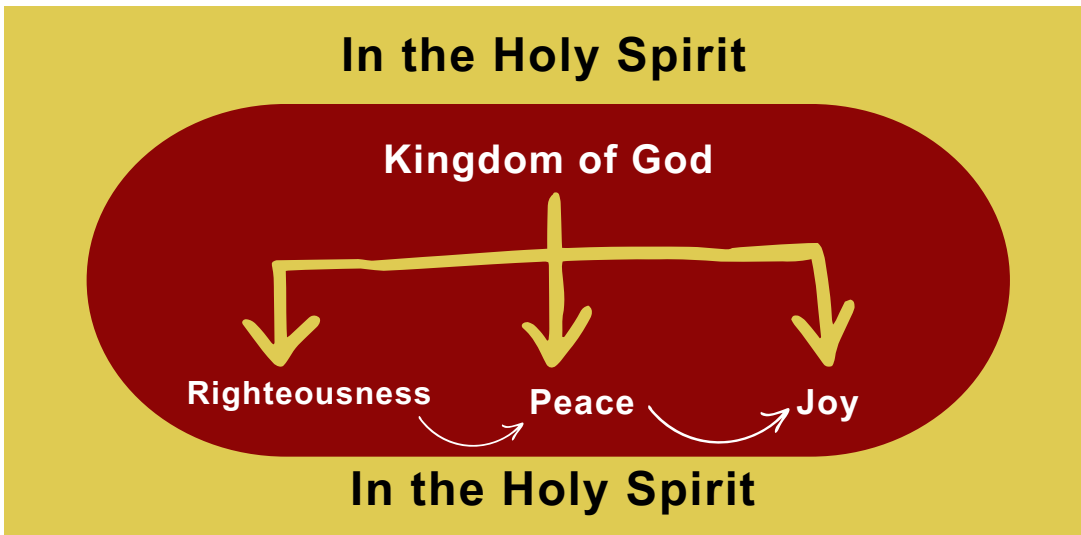

HEAVEN'S ESTABLISHMENT

Let's do some inventory- Righteousness

- If you answered yes- then let's dive deeper. According to the word of God, if you have believed the Gospel, you have been counted as righteous. That's truth. You are righteous. Let's confront every lie that is telling you otherwise.

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any lie that you are believing that contradicts the reality of righteousness that Jesus purchased on the cross.

- Identify the lie.
- Come out of agreement with the lie.
- Wholeheartedly receive the truth.
