Welcome to Rhinebeck School of Music's Beginner Ukulele Course with Erin Hobson!

This course is designed for complete beginners, but is also helpful for anyone who wants to brush up on technique, dive deeper into rhythm, expand chord vocabulary, and add songs to their repertoire.

Through the video lessons and accompanying PDFs, you will be provided with everything the beginner ukulele player needs to be able to grasp the basics of playing.

By the end of this course you will have learned:

- The different types of ukuleles, their features and parts.
- How to tune the instrument.
- How to play five basic chords and be able to change between them.
- Right hand techniques and different strumming patterns to accompany your chords.
- Simple melodies, playing one note at a time, across a number of strings with proper left hand technique.
- How to apply this knowledge and play songs.

Each video tutorial contains a bulk of content that is broken down later into smaller sections with play-along videos for you to practice to. PDFs are available to download with each video. The main goal of this course is to teach you how to play the ukulele with very little obstacles, so that you can just focus on playing the instrument.

While the ability to read standard notation is certainly a valuable skill (and one which I highly recommend), it falls beyond the scope of this course.

As such, all melodic information in this book is presented as tablature so that the inability to read music does not act as a barrier to those who wish just to play!
