INTRODUCTION

Your vision (<u>chazon</u>) is God's will and purpose for you
 your <u>life-assignment</u>."

I. YOUR VISION WILL <u>COST</u> YOU YOUR LIFE.

- A. Mark 8:34-35 (AMP)
- B. God's *chazon* will cost you everything.
 - 1. Be prepared to surrender everything to God.
 - 2. The areas of your life you do <u>not</u> surrender will hinder you from fulfilling God's will.
- C. As you let go of your <u>carnal</u> life, He unfolds your <u>true</u> life in Him!
- D. Only after Elisha followed Elijah across Jordan the place of self-emptying could he receive his "double-portion," his life-assignment.

II. NOT EVERYONE WILL AGREE WITH YOUR VISION.

- A. Acts 21:12-13 (AMP)
- B. God takes us to a place others cannot or will not go.

III. YOUR VISION MUST BE BIGGER THAN YOU.

- A. God will never call you to do something <u>you</u> can do.
 - 1. If your vision is smaller than your ability, it is not from God!
 - 2. Zechariah 4:6
- B. God is a generational God.
- C. You must prepare to turn over the mantle to the <u>next</u> generation.
 - 1. David knew when he was finished.
 - 2. These are steps for a wise master builder.
- D. Be sure you find the person or entity whom <u>God</u> has chosen to succeed you.
