Materials

Kraft Cardstock (Kendall Manila Buff Cardstock from the Color Youniversity Store), Faber Castell Polychromo Pencils (24 box +Beige Red 132 and Pine Green 267), White Paint Pen or White Gel Pen, Pencil Sharpener, Pencil Eraser, 6"x6" White Card Blank (or white card to make one), Yellow Striped and Green Spotted Paper (I use the SA Stripes and Dots 6x6 Pad), Tan and Green Ink Pads (I use SA Hybrid Inks – Mocha, Marigold, Apple Green and Bamboo), Blending Brush and Detail Blending Brush, Bamboo Stencil (I use the SA Bamboo Stencil), Clear/Standard Masking Tape, Adhesive, 3D Foam, Guillotine or Craft Knife with Ruler, Tweezers, Scissors, paper for making a stamp mask (I use printable vellum).

<u>Prep</u>

Print out (13cm x 13cm) Mud Pack Greyscale Topper onto Kendal Manilla Buff Cardstock. Also print Digistamp with dark outline to refer to whilst colouring.

Create a 6"x6" white card blank.

Print topper onto paper suitable for masking, I used printable vellum. (It is to mask off the image we have coloured, so we can use the stencil over the top.)
