Use the Digital Scrapper Community Actions to make quick work of splitting double pages and saving for web.



How To Delete Prior Versions Of This Action

I recommend deleting prior versions of this action before loading the newest version.

- In the Actions panel (Window > Action), click on the DS Community 2024 action folder to activate it.
- Click on the Trash icon and click OK.





Load the Action Set

- In the Actions panel (Window > Action), click on the panel menu and choose Load Actions.
- Navigate to the DS Community 2024C.atn file (latest version) and click Open.

Double Page Split

Use the Dbl-Pg-Split actions to split a layered double page into two single pages that are **ready for printing**.

- Open a layered double-page document (square, landscape, or portrait). I'm using a double square page.
- In the Actions panel, click on a DBL-PG-Split action to activate it and click on the Play icon. Follow the prompts.
- Rename the JPG files as desired.
- Watch the video for visual support.





Save For Web

Use the Save For Web actions to transform a print-size document into a sharable-size document.

- Open a print-size document. This can be flat (JPG) or layered (PSD). I'm using a layered 12x12 square document.

NOTE: The Save For Web - 12x12 action will work for any square size (10x10, 8x8, etc).

- In the Actions panel, click on a Save For Web action to activate it and click on the Play icon. Follow the prompts.
- Rename the JPG file as desired. I recommend adding “-web” to the end of the filename.
