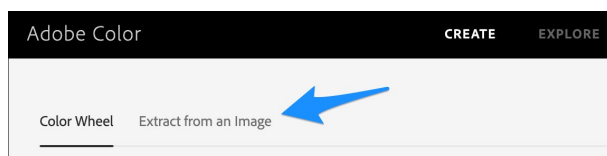

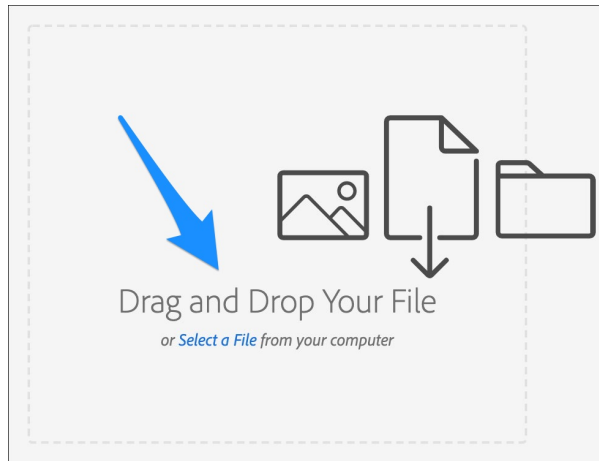
- Go to <https://color.adobe.com/create> or search for Adobe Color and click on the Create tab.
- Login with your Adobe ID.

#### Option 1: Get Swatches from An Image

- Click on Extract from an Image.

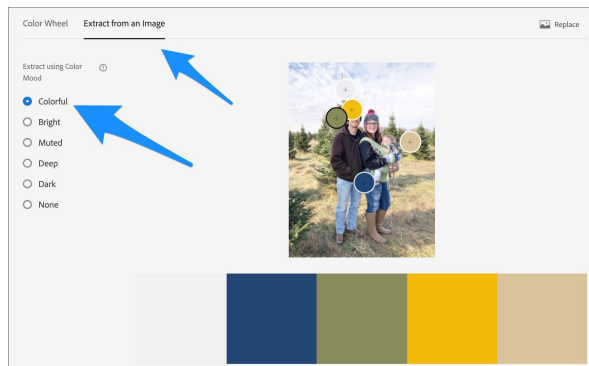


- Click and drag one of your Mastery 2 photos into the Drag and Drop section of the webpage.

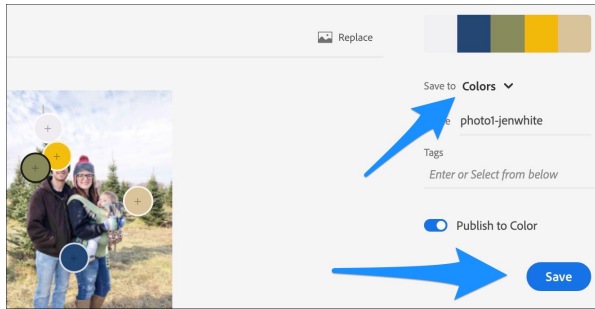


- Choose from one of the Color Moods.

NOTE: If you don't like any of the choices, click on Replace in the upper-right corner and use one of the other two photos you chose for Mastery 2.

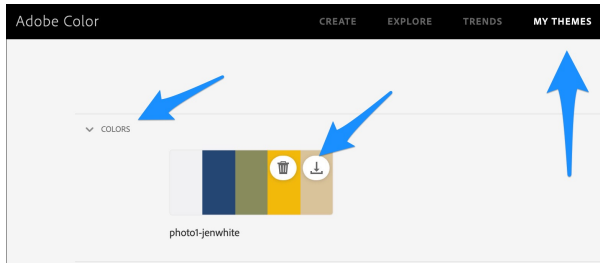


- Click on the Save to dropdown menu and choose Colors. Click Save.



- Click on the My Themes tab.
- Click on the down arrow to show Colors.
- Hover your cursor over the swatches and click on the Download icon.

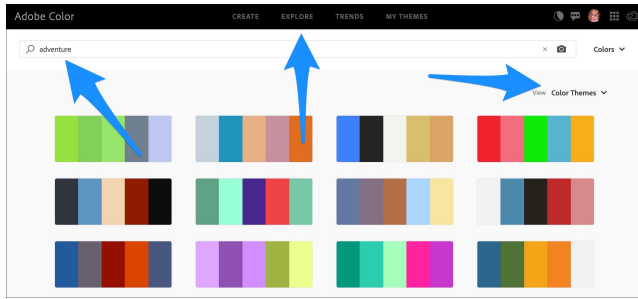
NOTE: The file will save to your computer as a .ase file. You will be using it in the next video.



### Option 2: Get Swatches

If you don't care for the swatches, know you have the option to use all black and white photos and then a color theme of any kind. This is a great option if your photos do not match in color or if the colors are simply bad.

- Go to <https://color.adobe.com/explore> or search for Adobe Color and click on the Explore tab.
- In the Search bar, enter a word that goes well with the subject of your scrapbook page. I entered "adventure."
- Click on View and choose Color Themes.



- Hover your cursor over a theme you like and click on the Download icon.

NOTE: You do not have to use all the colors in the theme you choose.
