


Combine Photo & Background Templates

- Open a Scrap It Now background template (File > Open).
- In the Menu Bar, choose File > Duplicate and click OK. (PS: Choose Image > Duplicate.)
- In the Layers panel, click on the top layer to activate it.
- Close the original file.
- Open a Scrap It Now photo template.
- In the Layers panel, click on the top layer to activate it.
- Holding down the Shift key click on the layer above the Background layer. Now all template layers, except the Background layer, should be active.
- Get the Move tool. In the Tool Options, Auto-select should be unchecked.
- Holding down the Shift key, click and drag from the current document to the duplicate template.
- Close the temporary photo template without saving.



- The new layers should still be active in the Layers panel, on the document click and drag on the layers to reposition them.
- To activate one layer all by itself, click to activate it in the Layers panel.

Note: Make sure the complex photo masks are not traveling over the edge of a 3D object, such as a strip of paper.
